# LETTER FROM THE CHAIR

On behalf of the American Academy of Implant Dentistry Foundation (AAIDF), I extend our heartfelt gratitude for your unwavering support and generosity. Your contributions have been instrumental in advancing our mission and making a significant impact in the field of implant dentistry.

We are thrilled to share some of the remarkable achievements made possible by your donations.

The *Smile*, Veteran!<sup>™</sup> program furthered our mission of dental care by giving back directly to our communities. The *Smile*, Veteran!<sup>™</sup> program treatment providers donate dental care to a local Veteran in need of dental implants. This year the program doubled the number of patients served and awarded almost \$5,000 for dental lab services.

In 2023, the Foundation, with the support of the Buhite-DiMino Foundation and our generous members, founded the Robert J. Buhite Scholarship Endowment. This new initiative expands the impact of the Foundation. In addition to our commitment to advancing implant dentistry through research grants, we are now nurturing the next generation of clinicians through this educational scholarship.



Our flagship programs, the Large Research Grants and Steflik Student Research Grants, awarded over \$105,000 to researchers at seven institutions in our mission to actively advance the field of implant dentistry. Since our founding, we have collectively awarded more than \$1.3 million in grant funding to support research projects at 63 institutions across eight countries.

None of these initiatives would be possible without the generosity and support of AAID members and the dental community at large. Our annual Silent Auction continues to be a major success, raising around \$80,000 in 2024; these donations are reinvested each year into our charitable programs. I thank the AAID and the Foundation leaders who actively champion the Foundation through the Annual Board Challenge fundraiser.

# SMILES TRANSFORMED IN 2024

The following lives were transformed as a part of the *Smile*, Veteran!<sup>™</sup> program in 2024.

#### Ms. R'Nita Rabelais was treated by Edward Kusek, DDS, FAAID, DABOI/ID.

Ms. Rabelais served 20 years as a member of the U.S. Airforce. She underwent surgery on her maxillary during her service with several fillings and ill-fitting veneers, meant to be a temporary solution for cavities and missing teeth. Dr. Edward Kusek placed ten implants with maxillary and mandibular hybrid dentures after extractions. Since her treatment,

Ms. Rabelais has since enjoyed a more restored smile and renewed social confidence.

#### Mr. D<mark>aniel Grec</mark>o was <mark>trea</mark>ted by Stephen Kondorossy, DMD, AFAAID.

Mr. Greco served in the U.S. Army for thirty years. He received a root canal during his service in Germany to fix cracked teeth from fillings provided by the Army. Mr. Greco had several teeth extracted and bridges put in over the years that contributed to tinnitus and further tooth decay. He suffered from a lack of ability to eat comfortably and reduced social interactions as a result of his dental problems. Dr. Kondorossy placed 15 implants, fixed partial dentures, and an upper implant bridge to restore Mr. Greco's smile.

#### Mr. John Meschi was treated by Donald Provenzale, DDS, FAAID, DABOI/ID.

Mr. Meschi was a private in the U.S. Marine Corps. For more than 10 years, he suffered from lack of stability of maxillary dentures and edentulism. Dr. Provenzale provided an implantsupported bridge as a part of Mr. Meschi's treatment. The dental implants and related components for this case were supplied gratis by a representative of Neodent USA. Mr. Meschi's quality of life has improved immensely since treatment – he has a renewed

ability to eat and chew various foods and enhanced social interactions. The Foundation extends its gratitude to Neodent USA for their support of this case.

#### Sgt. Antonio Chatman was treated by Robert Pauley, DMD, AFAAID.

Sgt. Chatman was a staff sergeant for the U.S. Airforce. He had cavities filled during his service in the military; when these fillings fell out, it resulted in tooth loss and periodontal disease. He also had chipped teeth and infection as a result of a housefire he narrowly escaped after his return home from service. Dr. Pauley performed extractions and bone grafting, followed by restorations of individual sites with single tooth implants and crown placements. Sgt. Chatman's confidence increased significantly after treatment, and he no longer feels the need to cover his mouth with his hand when talking with others. Tatum Surgical donated all implants and parts for

# FOUNDATION RESEARCH GRANTS

From its inception, the Foundation proudly offered grants for research in the field of oral implantology. Collectively, the Foundation has invested \$1.3 million into the future of dental implant research and helped shaped the next generation of innovation in implant dentistry. To date, the Foundation has supported a total of 96 projects from 64 schools in 8 countries.

#### 2024 Steflik Grants

The David R. Steflik Grants are a beacon of opportunity for dental students in post-graduate and residency programs, supporting their deserving research projects. Each grant, valued at \$2,000, empowers these future leaders to pursue innovative and impactful oral implantology research studies.

In 2024, the Foundation awarded Steflik grants to three exceptional projects, each selected for their potential to make significant contributions to dental implant research:

**Dr. Tarik Patel, University of Toronto, and Dr. Gerald Niznick, College of Dentistry, Canada** Evaluating the efficiency of the different resilient overdenture attachments in implant-assisted cast partial dentures

#### Dr. Pearl Silveira, Government Dental College, Thiruvanthapuram, India

Evaluation of the antibacterial activity of silver nanoparticles green synthesized using Mooring oleifera leaf extract on peri-implant disease pathogens Porphyromonas gingivitis and Fusobacterium nucleate - an in vitro study.

# Dr. Louis Asimakopoulos, Indiana University School of Dentistry, United States

Evaluation of implant stability and accuracy of static computer-assisted implant surgery (sCAIS) in different bone densities between two different implant designs.

#### 2024 Large Grants

The Foundation Large Research Grants provide support for meritorious dental implant research projects. These grants help researchers develop and test new techniques and procedures, conduct small clinical or animal research projects, analyze grant data, and explore the feasibility of larger-scale projects.

In 2024, the Foundation proudly awarded a total of \$105,800 in Large Research Grants, with each grant amounting up to \$25,000. Here are the remarkable projects that received support:

# 2024 Annual Board Challenge Fundraiser


et \$32,000 Raise
