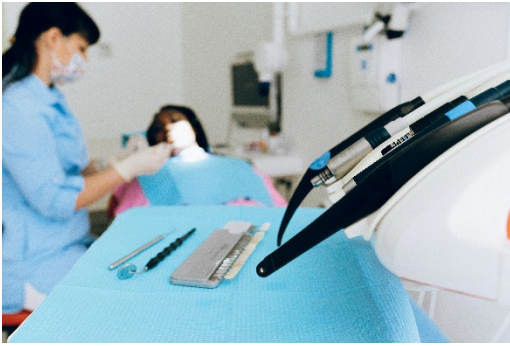




AAID Foundation Large and Student Grants

AAIDF Grants Opportunities

Large Research Grants

The AAIDF Research Grants Program is intended to provide limited support for meritorious dental implant research projects.

Applicants may request **up to \$25,000** to fund a project for up to a two-year grant period. Successful applicants who require additional time to perform the proposed research may request a no-cost extension of the grant period without additional monetary support.



David Steflik Memorial Student Research Grants

Student Research Grant Applicants may request **up to \$2,000** to fund their research project for up to a two-year grant period. Applicants also have the opportunity to attend the AAID Annual Conference and present project findings once the research is complete, with reimbursement for travel costs.

Where to Apply

Grant applications to the AAID Foundation are accepted through an online program. You will need to prepare supporting documentation, so the files are ready to upload when you begin the application.
