There is a high demand for German teachers, and it will only increase over the next decade.

## 3 million

How much student enrollment in public schools is projected to grow by 2025. Student enrollment from 2007 - 2015 has remained relatively the same, around 49 million.

## 35%

The decrease from 2009-2014 in teacher preparation program enrollments.

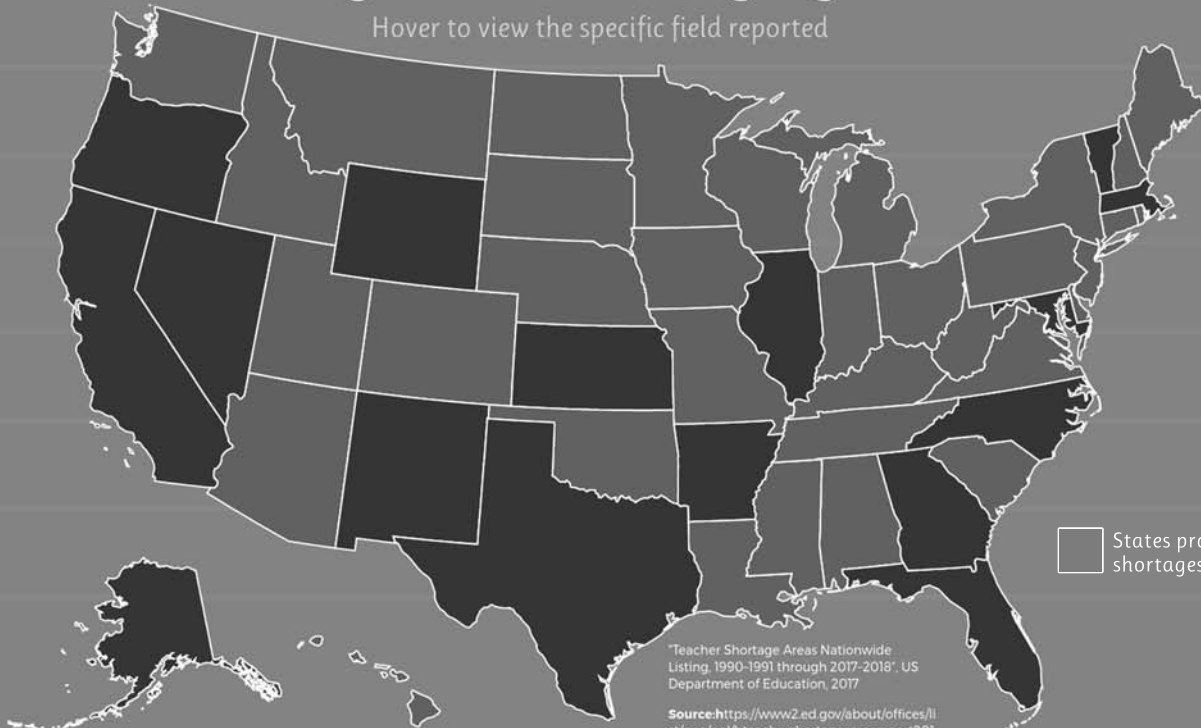

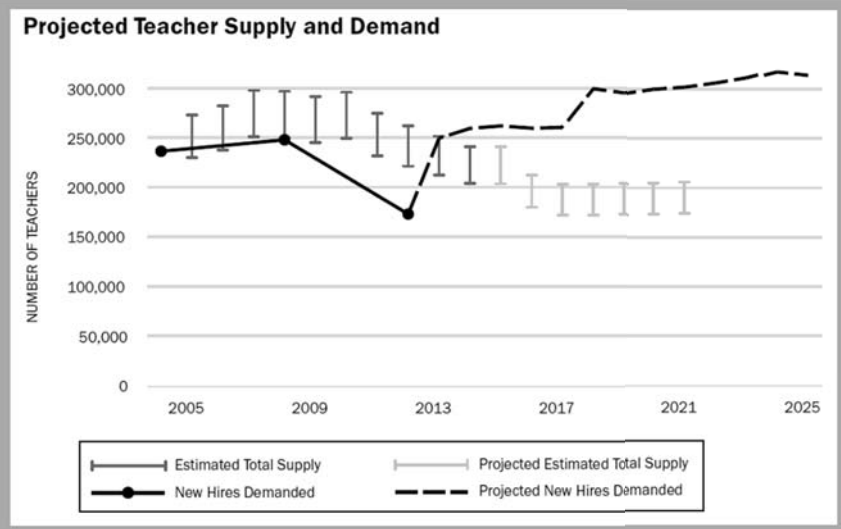

Across all subjects there are currently not enough qualified teachers to meet demand in the US. Projections through 2025 indicate there will be a shortage of over 100,000 teachers annually.
