

Mayor Issues Emergency Order EO-14 v2

Today, Mayor Ethan Berkowitz signed [Emergency Order EO-14 v2](#) that directly impacts hospitality businesses within the Municipality of Anchorage. EO-14 v2 returns our community to a modified version of Phase Two in the Safe Anchorage: Roadmap to Reopening the Municipality of Anchorage plan. EO-14 v2 sets limitations for individuals, gathering sizes, the hospitality industry, indoor gyms, bingo halls, theaters and other recreation and entertainment facilities. These regulations supersede EO-10, in part, and take effect **Monday, August 31, 2020 at 12:00 a.m., once EO-15 expires.**
