Why get vaccinated?

The COVID-19 vaccine helps protect you from COVID-19 infection and severe disease. It is safe and highly effective. Vaccination is a safer way to build immunity and is an important tool to help stop the pandemic.

Who can get the vaccine now?

Vaccine appointments are open to:

- Age 55 or above
- Essential workers
- Considered "high risk" due to health conditions
- Living in multigenerational housing, congregate settings or communities with limited plumbing
- Assisting someone who is 65 years or above to a vaccine appointment

Criteria apply to vaccine managed by the State of Alaska. Vaccine managed by the Alaska Tribal Health System, U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs and the U.S. Department of Defense may have different eligibility criteria. Moderna's vaccine and Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine are authorized for ages 18 and up, and Pfizer's vaccine is authorized for people ages 16 and up.
