Who is eligible to receive the COVID-19 VACCINE

Vaccine appointments are open to:

- Age 55 and above
- Essential workers
- Considered "high risk" due to health conditions
- Living in multigenerational housing, congregate settings or communities with limited plumbing
- Assisting someone who is 65 years or above to a vaccine appointment

*Limitations apply. Please check your eligibility online at *http://covidvax.alaska.gov*

Criteria apply to vaccine managed by the State of Alaska. Vaccine managed by the Alaska Tribal Health System, U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs and the U.S. Department of Defense may have different eligibility criteria. Moderna's vaccine and Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine are authorized for ages 18 and up, and Pfizer's vaccine is authorized for people ages 16 and up.

How do l schedule an appointment?

Eligible Alaskans can schedule an appointment with an Alaska COVID-19 vaccine provider online or over the phone.
