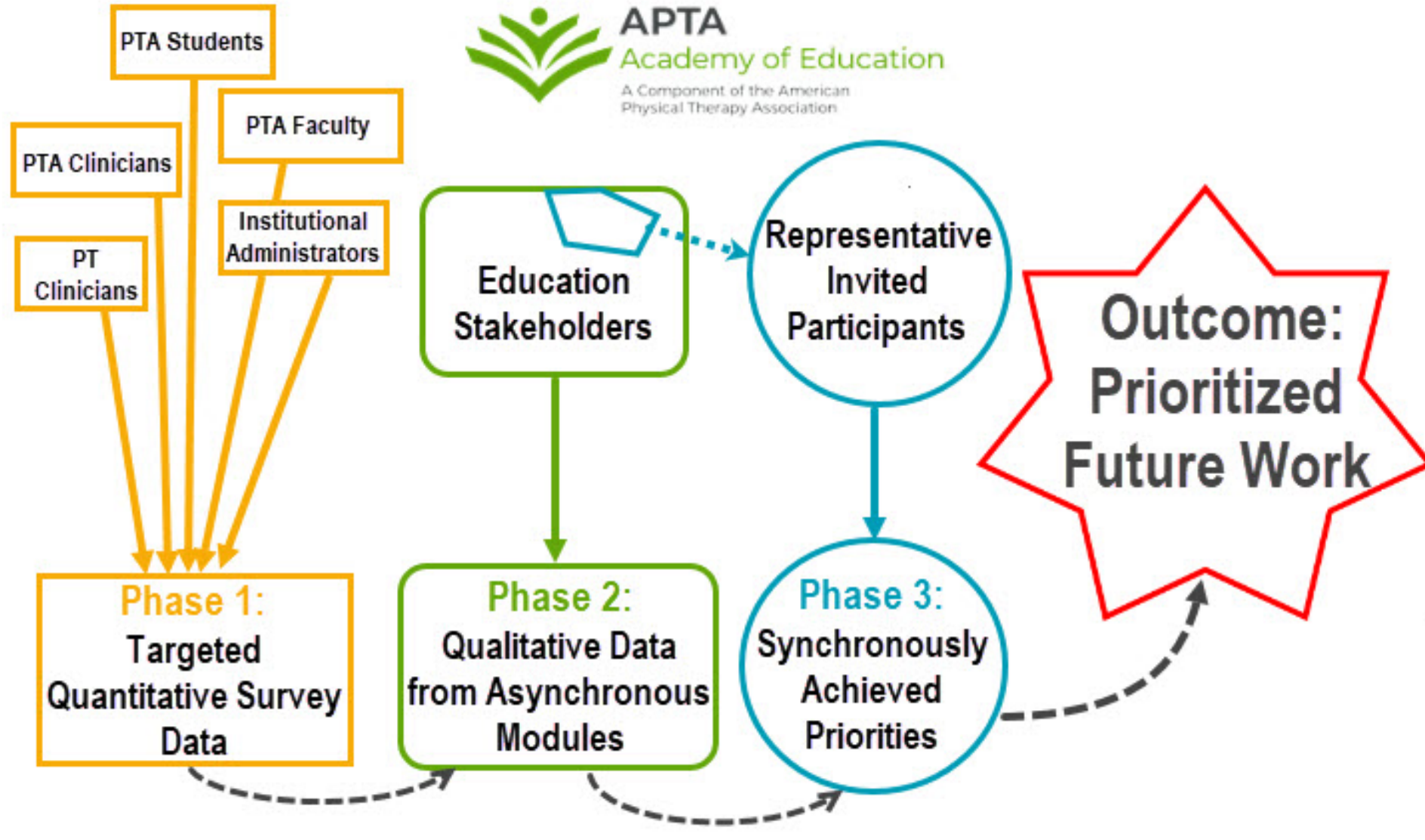

Open Positions: Academic Co-Chair (DCE/ACCE)

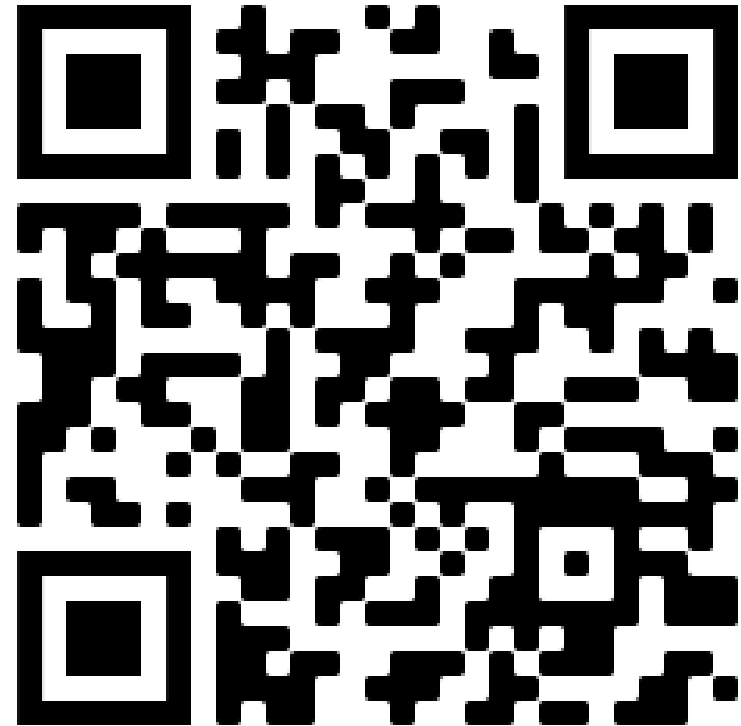

The Nominating Committee shall present a slate of two or more qualified candidates, if possible, for the appropriate offices annually at the CESIG business meeting.

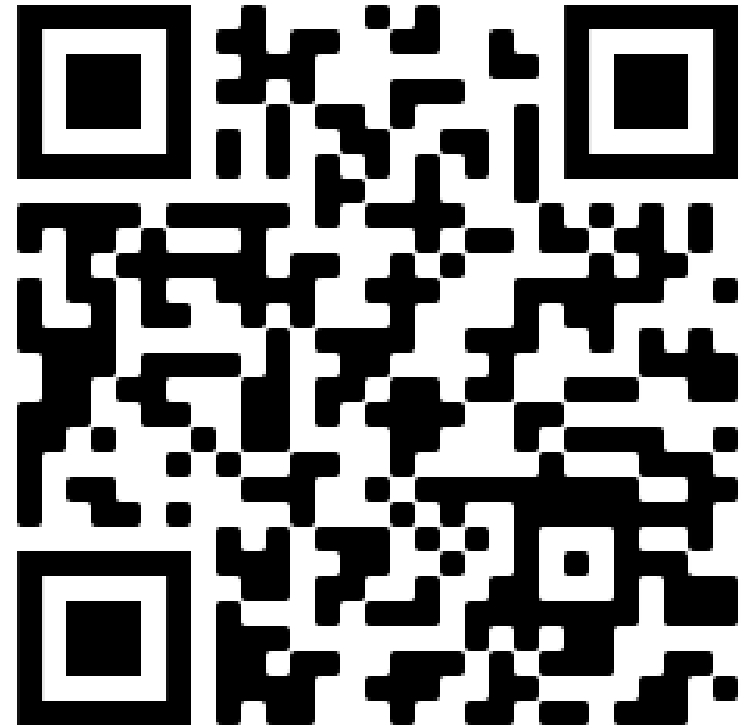
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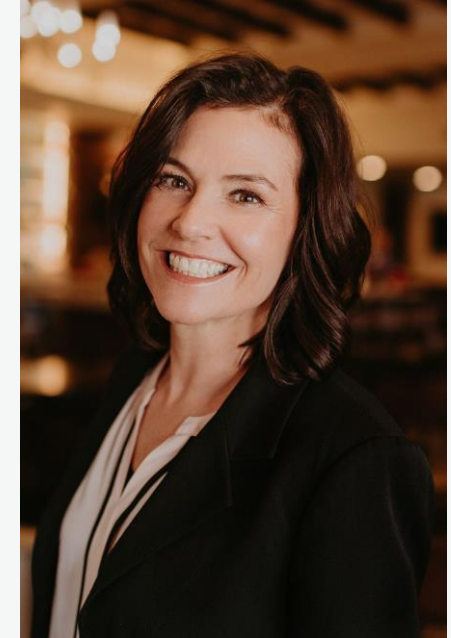

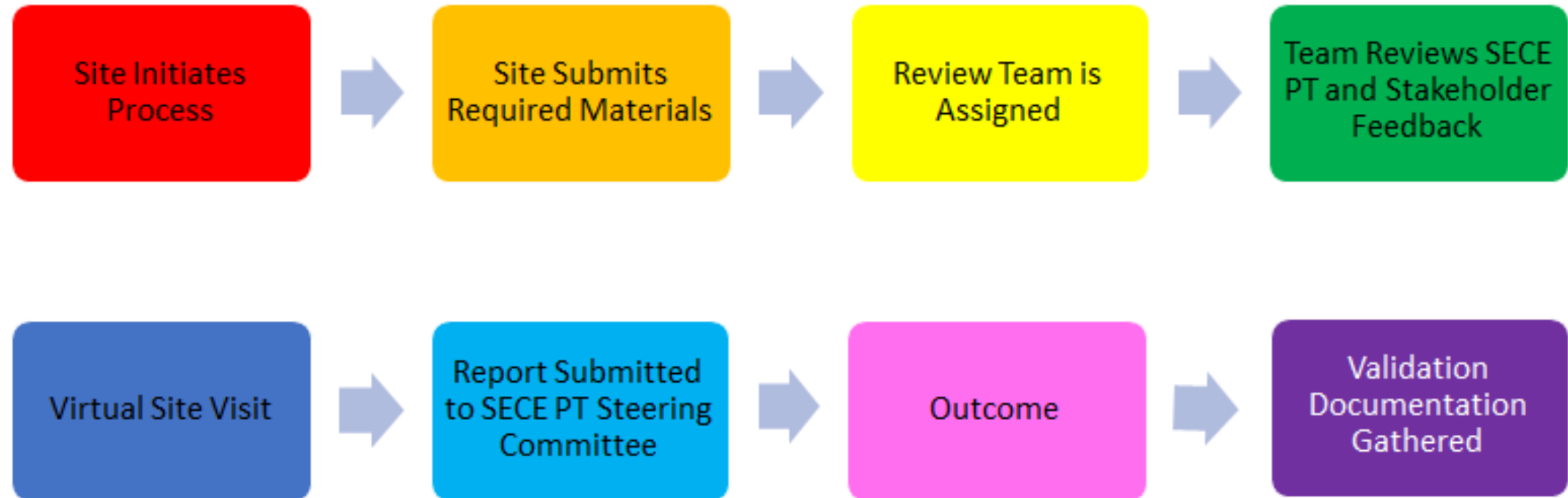

Updates on Placement Process Task Force

Recommendation 2: “Adopt an annual clinical education placement timeline that guides initial placement requests, offer confirmations, notices of unused offers and secondary placement requests.”

- March 1st Mailing Date (Academic)
- April 30th Response Date (Clinic)
- June 30th Confirmation of Acceptance (Academic)
- October 1 Secondary Request (Academic)
- November 30 Response Date for Secondary Request (Clinical)
- December 31 Confirm Acceptance of Secondary Placement (Academic)

Recommendation 3: “Provide professional training and development for Directors of Clinical Education and Site Coordinators of Clinical Education, especially those new to these positions.”
