June 1948 Creation of Sections provided in (APTA) Bylaws
June 1949 Rules of Government adopted

Purpose:

1. To consider, discuss and recommend standards relative to admission, curriculum, teaching practices, clinical training and administration for schools of physical therapy approved by the Council on Medical Education and Hospitals of the American Medical Association.
2. To receive for discussion any matters concerning the education of physical therapists.
3. To make recommendations to the Executive Committee and to the Committee on Education of the American Physical Therapy Association.

June 1956 Rules of Government amended - name changed to

Section on Education

Dec. 1956 Rules of Government approved by (APTA) Board of Directors

Purpose: to promote the professional growth and development of the members by providing opportunities to investigate, interpret, evaluate and exchange ideas on educational philosophies, trends and practices.
