Advocacy Update:
Dept of Education RISE Committee Examines
Definition of Professional Degrees

The The Department of Education's Reimagining and Improving Student Education (RISE) Committee adopted a narrow definition for what constitutes a "professional degree," and did not include the DPT on its list. If this definition is adopted, students pursuing degrees that are not considered "professional degrees" would have borrowing for federal student loans limited to \$20,500/year and would have a \$100,000 lifetime cap. 2026 Promotion of Doctoral Studies Scholarships Applications are Open!



In 2026, the APTA Academy of Education is supporting an award available to precandidate doctoral students (\$7,500) or doctoral candidates (\$15,000). Applicants must be members of both APTA and the Academy at the time the application is submitted.

Doctoral students and candidates who are focused on PT education research are not limited to this award. They may apply and be eligible for non-restricted awards, too.

Call for Program Director:

Excellence in Education Certificate Program



The APTA Academy of Education is seeking an experienced and visionary educator to guide the transition of its Excellence in Education Certificate (EEC) program from development to sustainable implementation. The program director will provide leadership in operationalizing the program structure, refining content and mentoring processes, and ensuring academic integrity, learner engagement, and scalability as the program evolves.

About the Program

The Excellence in Education Certificate program supports the professional growth of current and aspiring educators, including clinicians interested in or transitioning to academic roles. This program enhances an understanding of the academic environment through participant mentorship and the development of a solid foundation in learning sciences and educational methodologies. Empowered with essential knowledge, skills, abilities, and resources, participants will contribute meaningfully to educational programs.

The Excellence in Education Certificate (EEC) program will employ a blended learning model, delivering content through asynchronous and synchronous modules to meet the growing demand of developing future and current educators across the many realms of physical therapy education including clinical, academic, and residency/fellowship arenas. A critical core of content modules is linked simultaneously to traditional CEU requirements and professional licensing needs. The program will require a minimum of 60 total contact hours, a certificate examination, and 10 hours of direct mentoring by experts in the field. Formative assessments will be utilized at the end of each content module, linked to CEU credits, followed by a summative examination to earn the certificate. To accommodate aspiring candidates, mentored synchronous activities will be scheduled primarily, but not exclusively, during evenings or on weekends.

Call for Program Director

The APTA Academy of Education Board of Directors is accepting applications now through November 21, 2025 for a program director for its Excellence in Education certificate program.

The program director would be expected to provide strategic leadership for the following activities:

Program Leadership and Strategic Oversight

- Guide the transition from consultant-led development to a fully operational, sustainable certificate program.
- Ensure ongoing refinement of program infrastructure, policies, and procedures for curriculum management, assessment, and quality assurance.
- Serve as the primary liaison between the EEC team, Academy staff/leadership, content developers, and mentors.
- Ensure all program elements align with APTA Academy of Education strategic

priorities and contemporary educational best practices.

Curriculum and Content Quality

- Lead the culminating review, integration, and finalization of all Phase I modules, ensuring consistency and instructional quality.
- Implement peer review processes to maintain rigor and relevance.
- Oversee the development and integration of assessment strategies, including formative module assessments and the summative certificate exam.

Mentorship and Faculty Development

- Develop and implement the mentoring framework for participants, including mentor recruitment, training, and matching processes.
- Support mentors in applying adult learning principles and reflective teaching practices.

Program Implementation and Evaluation

- Oversee the pilot cohort, collect and analyze feedback, and guide iterative improvements.
- Develop a plan for continuous quality improvement, including data tracking and outcome metrics.
- Collaborate with Academy staff on marketing, communication, and participant engagement strategies.

Reporting and Communication

- Provide regular written and verbal updates to the Executive Committee and Board of Directors, including progress summaries, key decisions, and recommendations.
- Communicate timelines, deliverables, and progress benchmarks to all stakeholders.

The program director will begin January 5, 2026 and serve through December 31, 2026, with an option for renewal based on program needs and mutual agreement.

Compensation: Commensurate with experience, up to \$10,000 for initial contract period, with renewal potential based on scope and deliverables.

Required Experience and Qualifications

- Doctoral degree (DPT, PhD, EdD) in Physical Therapy, Education, or related field.
- Demonstrated leadership in program development, curriculum design, or continuing education initiatives.
- Proven experience mentoring educators or clinicians in academic or professional development settings.
- Familiarity with CEU/continuing professional development standards and online learning platforms.
- Strong organizational, communication, and project management skills.
- Prior experience with APTA Academy of Education programs or initiatives preferred.

This position offers a unique opportunity to shape an Academy of Educationendorsed professional development program that advances teaching excellence across all domains of physical therapy education. Interested applicants should submit a CV and letter of interest highlighting leadership experience, educational expertise, and a vision for developing the next generation of educators.

Elections will be held in the Spring of 2026.

Only members who meet the following criteria AND consent to serve shall be eligible for election to office:

- Be a member of the Academy as provided for in the Association bylaws for a period of at least one year immediately preceding the nomination deadline.
- Be a member of the SIG for a period of at least one year immediately preceding the nomination deadline.
- Candidates for Chair or Co/Vice Chair must have been continuous members in good standing of the Academy for a period of at least two years immediately preceding the nomination deadline.

No candidate may be considered for two positions simultaneously.

Please note: The Academy recently added the Secretary position to this call.

Per Academy policy, the nominating committees, after review of all submitted candidate materials, shall select no more than three (3) nominees for each open position.


