Mentor training occurs across the program and is linked together through technology. See below the platforms that they use for communication and tracking.

- Besides live mentor training course (s), additional ongoing training and communication through a shared drive form which requires the mentor to record the resident's performance in several areas, including clinical content and basic clinical reasoning based on expectations established by the program, use of care extenders, use of Medbridge in HEP interventions, use of outcomes including PSFS, documentation and billing, professional behaviors.
- After a 4-hour block of time, the mentor completes a "mentor report." This mentor report is an electronic document with drop down lists, and auto populating fields that serve to remind the mentor on the stages of skill acquisition
- Outlook calendar invitation to schedule mentor sessions, and communicate need forms
- MedBridge Knowledge Tracks to convey (and create) parts of the curriculum
- Residents work electronically (through email and One Drive) to collaborate on answers to questions from our web site (Ask the Expert Questions), with the supervision of a mentor.
