

ASC TRAINING ACADEMY CERTIFICATE PROGRAM & WEBINARS

The Adhesive and Sealant Council's Training Academy Certificate program or TAC was developed in response to ASC's 'Long Range Plan' strategic initiative to create a curriculum for adhesive and sealant professionals to grow and learn throughout their career. The TAC program was launched in mid-2016 and can count **827 graduates** from all disciplines in the adhesive and sealant industry.

THE TAC PROGRAM offers a structured curriculum to provide the necessary fundamentals and focused adhesive and sealant education for a holistic understanding of the technical and business issues within the adhesive and sealant industry.

- 100% web-based program utilizing live and on demand recorded webinars.
- Each graduate must pass proficiency exams for 12 required courses within one year.
- Six mandatory CORE courses include: Adhesion, Adhesives, Sealants, Polymer Science, Testing and Formulation Principles. These courses were specifically developed for the TAC program and are not available anywhere else.
- Six FOCUS courses are chosen by learner to maximize relevancy in: Markets and Technologies (three courses), Chemistry (two courses) plus one elective course. The FOCUS library contains over 65 courses and growing.

TAC access can be economically purchased through subscriptions or single access.

- Courses rotate through six technology topics: Waterborne Adhesives, Pressure Sensitive Adhesives, Polyurethane Adhesives, Hot Melt Adhesives, Caulks and Sealants, and Formulation Strategies.
- Courses are generally broad enough for commercial professionals but robust for technical staff.
- Connection with presenters and peers allows for growth of network and deeper understanding of topics.

These courses are ideal for adhesive and sealant chemists, application engineers, sales and marketing staff from manufacturers, raw material & equipment suppliers and end users of adhesives and sealants.

ASC SUSTAINABILITY INITIATIVE

In 2021, the ASC Board of Directors established the ASC Adhesive & Sealant Sustainability Initiative to advance and support sustainability efforts on behalf of members and the industry.

Our four strategic objectives are to:

- Source member case studies on sustainability initiatives to promote industry wins and highlight best practices.

What is the Innovation Awards Program?

The ASC Innovation Awards Program recognizes innovation in adhesive and sealant product developments. The awards identify significant impact chemistries that contribute to downstream industries unmet needs and advancements in technology. In step with ASC's Long Range Plan, ASC will help accelerate innovation by recognizing leading companies with this prestigious awards program. The awards are given annually and are presented on stage at ASC's Annual Convention each spring.

There is one category for "Best Innovation". ASC also recognizes the first and second runners-up. Raw material suppliers or manufacturers of adhesives and or sealants as well as academia can submit for the award.

Recipients of these awards will demonstrate the value proposition of the novel chemistry and added value in a field application or improvement in design and chemical process. To be eligible for an award(s), a nominated technology must meet the scope of the ASC Innovation Awards Program by meeting each of the specific five criteria. SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM



The ASC Scholarship Program began in 2017 by the late Rusty Thompson, former President of Evans Adhesive, beloved member of the ASC Board of Directors, and a friend and mentor to many in the adhesive industry. He strongly believed in assisting the next generation with achieving their collegiate goals in pursuit of their future career objectives.



The ASC Scholarship Program was initiated in memory of Gene Simmons, one of the industry's most experienced, knowledgeable and respected pressure sensitive adhesive formulators and mentors. In keeping with his spirit of willing mentorship, this award was started with the support of Evans Adhesive to support students in pursuit of their degree in a related field.

In 2024, ASC's Board of Directors renamed the program in Rusty's honor to the Rusty Thompson Memorial Scholarship.

Eligibility Requirements

To be considered for scholarship funds through the ASC Scholarship Program, candidates must:

- Be a full-time junior or senior at an accredited college, university, or community college.
- Be pursuing a degree in a science-related or business field of study.

Selection Process

The Selection Committee reviews all applications to determine the best overall applicants. Scholarships are awarded based on a recipient's relevant academic field of study, future career objective, and academic and/or leadership achievements. The highest-rated students are selected as scholarship recipients.

Award Amounts

Scholarships are awarded annually to 7-8 applicants, depending on the availability of funding, in an amount ranging between \$2,000-\$3,000 each, depending on the volume of selections.

ASC is a 501(c)(6) nonprofit organization, donations are not tax deductible. All donors/donor companies will be announced at the ASC Annual Convention each year along with the scholarship recipients.

Application

Applicants must submit a brief (750-1,500 words max) statement discussing: the applicant's key academic and extracurricular achievements, how their degree could be applied to a position in the adhesive and sealant industry, and their future career interest.

REGULATORY ADVOCACY FOCUS

What We Do to Keep Members Informed and Involved?

Adhesives and sealants are regulated at the federal, state, and local levels through a variety of government rules and regulations. Though most of our focus is on federal regulations, states such as California actively regulate adhesives and sealants at the state and regional level and require our engagement.

Monthly Regulatory Newsletter (members only — Each month ASC members receive a free newsletter via e-mail that summarizes important regulatory policy developments. The newsletter is produced each month by Thompson Hine LLP.

Convention Programming — Every convention features tracks dedicated to issues facing our industry. Attendees have the opportunity to hear directly from agencies such as the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, California Department of Toxic Substance Control or the South Coast Air Quality Management District on their latest proposals.

Regulatory Alerts—Changes to issues come quickly and ASC is committed to alerting you to any changes we are aware of within 24 hours of becoming notified. Those involved in environmental, health and safety issues should sign up for the alerts so they can move issues up the chain of command quickly.

Regulatory Update Webinars—Twice a year ASC offers webinars providing the latest information on critical regulatory issues while allowing members the opportunity to ask questions related to the significance of their particular operation.

Regulatory Affairs Committee—ASC members environment, health and safety personnel participate in phone conferences and meetings throughout the year reviewing issues and jointly developing industry positions for ASC articulation. These leaders ensure that our team is aware of the impact of any proposals in order for us to be effective advocates.

Adhesives in Flooring

Trampled under foot – can you imagine what carpet, parquet, linoleum and the like have to endure? Every day, people trip, scamper, shuffle, trudge and tramp on them. Sometimes in high heels, sometimes with rug-ged boots or other heavy foot-wear. Of course, the adhesive underneath the floor surface has to endure these loads as well.

Every day, armies of passengers, pilots, flight attendants and train conductor lug their baggage over them. Furthermore, floors and adhesives both have to stand up to other demands placed during regular cleaning using heavy machines and rotating brushes. Usually elastomer covering can be glued using dispersion adhesive which is selected to match the covering type. If the floor is subject or laoda, as is customary in railway stations or airports, they are glued with resin adhesives. Finally, temperature variations, solar radiation, moisture or heavy equipment as used for damp cleaning, add on to these strains.

In residential buildings, carpet, laminate, cork and adhesives are exposless harsh conditions. Still furniture castors and floor heating challenge material resistance. And the adhesive definitely has to hold up if junior decides to practice roller-skating on the carpet while mom is out shopp
