Job Description

Purpose of Position:

Oversees state legislative and regulatory agenda; Serves as staff liaison to the Interstate Committee; Provides compliance related services to members; Assists in editing and updating compliance-related publications and material; Serves as liaison to Departments, Divisions and Programs as assigned.

Requirements:

Maintains national association state government affairs program through establishing state and local-level strategic partnerships with state and regional affiliated association units and sister organizations to coordinate grassroots advocacy efforts.

Identifies, monitors and tracks state issues, legislation, and regulations that affect the industry; formulate policy recommendations

Advocates policies favorable to members, to state legislatures and holders of public office for the purpose of persuading them to support association positions

Responds to member and public inquires, including providing substantive answers and materials, as needed or makes referrals to the appropriate association resource

Manages the development of association relationships and alliances with key state legislators, opinion and business leaders, and other organizations that can help advance the association's mission through state public policy or industry practice
