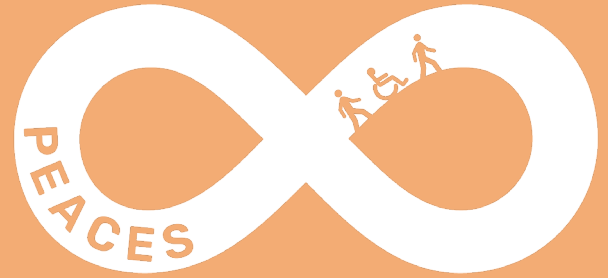


Supporting Autistic College Student Success: Three Tips for Disability Services Offices



In this Fast Fact, we offer recommendations for Disability Service Office (DSO) professionals who aim to support autistic college student success.



The recommendations offered here are based on a national survey we conducted with 425 autistic undergraduate college students in Fall 2022.

1. Less reliance on documentation in favor on more emphasis on students' statements of need
2. Expanding the range of accommodations to unique student needs (e.g., on-campus housing accommodations for autistic students)
3. Working with autistic students directly to develop new types of accommodations that may be helpful
