

New York Medicaid Coverage of Applied Behavior Analysis

Issue

Rather than reimbursing the tiered-delivery model, New York Medicaid is only reimbursing for services provided by a licensed behavior analyst (LBA) or certified behavior analyst assistant (CBAA).

Impact

Practically speaking, this means LBAs will be reimbursed \$76 per hour by New York Medicaid to provide essentially all ABA services to the Medicaid population. Access to medically necessary ABA services will be severely limited.

Needed Action

• Make a Parity Complaint

The exclusion of the tiered-delivery model is a non-quantitative treatment limit because it doesn't adhere to generally accepted standards of care (GASC). You can bring this to the attention of each of the agencies below:
