## AIRPORT AND GROUND TRANSPORTATION

There are many sustainable transportation options to get you from Denver International Airport (DEN) to downtown Denver. One of the easiest ways is the RTD A Line train that can get you downtown in 37 minutes! **The Denver Airport Station is located at the DEN Transit Center, Level 1, adjacent to the Westin Denver International Airport. One Airport Day Pass to take the A Line to Union Station is \$10.00 and can be purchased at the Airport Station or with the RTD MyRide App.** For a complete list of all the transit options and more information on accessing everything visit:
