Our next step is to secure the definition within the Senate version of the bill. I encourage all members to reach out to their Senators encouraging them to support this effort. On August 15, ACT will open voting for our 2023-24 Board of Directors, including Officers. As a member-based organization, we rely on the dedication of our volunteer leaders to guide the organization in the implementation of its strategic plan to achieve our vision of creating a better journey for everyone. TDM Defined in the Recently Passed NDAA

On July 14th, the U.S. House of Representatives passed the Fiscal Year (FY) 2023 National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA). Each year, the NDAA authorizes funding levels and provides policy authorizations for the U.S. military and other critical defense priorities. This year, the bill passed by the House also includes a key provision defining transportation demand management (TDM). The FY2023 NDAA includes language defining transportation demand management as "strategies to inform and encourage travelers to maximize the efficiency of a transportation system, leading to improved mobility, reduced congestion, and lower



vehicle emissions, including strategies that use planning, programs, policies, marketing, communications, incentives, pricing, data, and technology." The inclusion of this definition in a "must-pass" piece of legislation is a significant achievement for the TDM community.

"The inclusion of the TDM definition will go a long way towards educating travelers on different transportation options and ultimately reduce roadway congestion by opening more funding avenues for TDM projects," said **David Straus**, Executive Director of the Association for Commuter Transportation (ACT)...


