

ACT's <u>36th Annual International Conference</u> will be held in Chicago in just about two months. It is great to see nearly 300 people already registered for what promises to be a fabulous event. This year's event will feature an energizing keynote address, fun-filled opening reception, over 30 breakout sessions, chapter and council meetings, tours, and the return of Pre-Conference Workshops (see below). I know that many people may be thinking of waiting to register until we get closer to the conference but don't wait too long as our discounted hotel rooms will start to fill quickly!

ACT's **Future of Chapters Task Force** has continued its work to ensure ACT's chapters are structured to provide high value to the organization and our membership. In April, over 280 members provided great feedback through our Chapter Survey. Respondents represented both new and long-term members of ACT with 21% less than one year of membership, 34% with 2-5 years of membership, and 44% with 5+ years of membership in the organization. In the coming months the Task Force will continue to analyze the data gathered, conduct focused conversations with members, and begin developing initial draft recommendations to be presented to the Board.

Rhyss Leary is the Founder of GoPassGo Networks, a TDM focused solution provider that directly addresses the needs of organizations looking to reduce single ridership with tools that make it easier to conduct operations and integrate with partners (like transit agencies) and conduct commuter surveys to measure their effectiveness.

Rhyss says he hopes to achieve, "Full automation of the

commuter options process between all stakeholders (transit authorities, rideshare, carpool/vanpool, walking/bicycling and their partner organizations)" with his work at GoPassGo.

The ACT Shuttles Council is conducting a confidential survey on shuttles. We encourage all companies, institutions, property managers and TMAs who offer shuttles for short- or long-haul trips to complete the survey. The details and link to the survey itself are available below.

The survey results will be presented in an anonymized and aggregated form at the ACT Conference, and the summary report will then be available to ACT members and respondents. The information collected will help ACT promote the benefits and value of shuttle operations to policy makers and stakeholders.

The survey is open to both ACT and non-ACT members who offer shuttles. We encourage you to share this survey with peers and contacts to increase the amount of data gathered and help strengthen the case for increased support of these important operations. The more data we gather, the more valuable the results will be for everyone (and anyone who responds will receive a copy of the summary report).
