

Commuter Challenges in Rural Areas

Join us in the Central Shenandoah Valley to talk about transportation challenges in rural areas.

The event is hosted by the Central Shenandoah Planning District Commission and the RideShare Commuter Assistance Program. Join us as we gather to discuss the challenges in connecting commuters to their jobs in rural and small urban areas. Paula Melester, Regional Planner for the CSPDC, will give a brief presentation on the Afton Express commuter bus service and how that has helped connect commuters in the Shenandoah Valley to jobs in the Charlottesville Metropolitan Area.

The program will be held at the BRITE Transit Facility in Fishersville, VA, and will begin with a lunch at 11:30 am, followed by a presentation and discussion.
