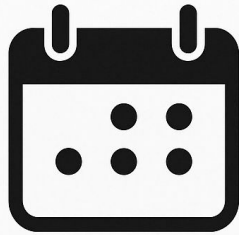

Capacity Building – What It Is

Activities, products, or processes that enhance infrastructure, resources, effectiveness, and efficiency

Reinforces the *foundation* of care

- Expand services to meet growing community need
- Invest in internal systems that make those services possible
- Support partnerships that encourage growth
- Strengthen an organization's ability to fulfill its mission and sustain operations

It's the difference between funding a bandage today and strengthening the entire healthcare system that prevents wounds tomorrow.



Capacity Building – What It Includes

Use funding to support behind the scenes processes or strategy *and* front-line care.

- **Personnel:** administrative, development and clinical staff
- **Programmatic Enhancements:** software, labs and medications, consulting
- **Operational Stability:** rent, utilities, audits, internet
- **Professional development, strategic planning, and more**
