





Graph A: Awarded Funds by County



Graph B: Funds Awarded by Clinic Structure




Graph C: Funds Awarded by Clinic Purpose

Patient Services Report Number 7/1/16 – 11/30/16

- **45 counties served**
- **145,823 visits (includes medical, dental, vision, mental health, and wellness)**
- **80,988 unduplicated patients**
- **72,530 Rx medications provided**
- **Half of our clinics provided medications to their patients**
- **62% of clinics were open more than 20 hours a week**
- **10,262 volunteers**
 - **5,973 health care professionals**
 - **4,289 lay**
- **84% operated only fixed clinic sites while the remaining 16% operated a mobile clinic or a specialty network**
- **51% of clinics serve children between the ages of 0 and 17**
