- V. Previous Meeting Minutes

- A. President Palm Beach Central High School (Isabella Ryan)
 - Began with a greeting. Reported that our first district meeting, hosted at

 was a collaboration with Speak Up For Kids Palm Beach to create
 birthday boxes for foster kids.

Has attended 2 virtual meetings with our District Executive Board in preparation for today's event, as well as assisted our Vice Presidents with some responsibilities for the meeting.

 - Began with a greeting. They have organized district funds, and dues, and have been preparing for the DV rally in February.

IX. New Business

- A. Resolution to Require Recycling Bins in all government-sponsored buildings Submitted by Park Vista High School

B. Constitutional Review

- 2. There are three proposed amendments, which will be discussed and voted on. All constitutional amendments must require a ½ vote to pass.
 - a) The first amendment was provided by Dr. Joaquin Garcia High School. Amendment 1 relates to spacing errors in different sections.

As this position was recently added to the District V Executive Board at last year's District Rally, there are currently no set rules for the election process.

1. Isabella Ryan announced that the District V project is for supporting children in our community. Information was provided on why this topic was chosen, the goal for the year, how the project will be broken down across the 3 District meetings, and how connections through the community find ways to impact the lives of children.

D. Other Announcements

- Dr. Joaquin Garcia High School announced that on February 12th, there will be a district-wide Chipotle fundraiser to allocate funds for the FASC 2026 State Conference. Schools within the district will have to set up a fundraiser with their local Chipotle.
- 2. Mr. Cordeiro announces that SFLTC will occur during the summer time and last for 5 days, from June 16th to June 20th. The location of the camp will be at Nova Southeastern University. Registration covers meals for every day, clothing, and housing. Registration costs around \$350.
