Freedom High School Student Government Association Student Leader Code of Conduct 2009-2010

It is a privilege and honor to be a member of this organization, but along with that comes responsibility. All student leaders are required to be active in campus organizations and/or athletics while maintaining a level of responsibility and leading by example.

- 1. Students are responsible for knowing their individual eligibility status. (refer to the Constitution)
- 2. Students will be required to maintain attendance in all classes as defined by the school attendance policy.
- 3. Students involved in any disciplinary action by the school or police will be subject to a probationary period or immediate removal from SGA.
 - a. This includes suspensions, referrals, attendance contracts, and arrests.
 - b. Students must be in accordance with the rules and regulations of the OCPS Student Code of Conduct at Freedom High School at all times.
- 4. Students who have below a 2.5 unweighted GPA, and/or have a D or F in any core course, and/or are not putting out appropriate academic effort will be placed on Academic Probation until their GPA, grades, or effort improve. Students placed on Academic Probation will not be permitted to participate in any SGA events during the probationary period. If grades do not improve within the next marking period, students will be subject to immediate removal of SGA privileges and possible removal from the class.
- 5. Students may be put on probation for improper conduct or disrespectful behavior including but not limited to obscene language, and/ or gestures, and insubordination. Hazing, intimidation, and harassment of fellow members can also result in probation.
- 6. Any equipment or materials issued to a student and not returned, or returned in a damaged condition must be paid for by the student.
- 7. Students are not permitted to leave the classroom without permission from the sponsor. Students must sign out of the classroom after receiving permission and must wear his/her SGA badge while out of the classroom.
- 8. Students are to show respect towards peers, teachers, administrators, and others at all times.
- 9. Students are required to attend all mandatory Student Government meetings and events.
- 10. Students are required to maintain active involvement within their committees.
- 11. A committee that includes the sponsor of the organization, assistant principal and the principal of the school will decide on any action that results in the dismissal of a member from the Student Government Association.

Remember that it is both a privilege and an honor to be selected as a member of the Student Government Association.
