EXPECTATIONS - 3 YEAR TERM

- FASA is affiliated with the National Association of Elementary School Principals (NAESP) and has a state representative to work alongside the national organization for advocacy and more.
- This role is for elementary or middle school principals who are also members of NAESP.
- This role serves on the FAEMSP and FASA Boards.
- State Level:
 - Attend two in-person FAEMSP and FASA Board meetings (Advocate and Discover conferences) as well as any conference calls necessary (usually 2-4 per year) for both Boards.
 - Attend the 2-day FASA strategic planning session in the fall of even years.
- National Level:
 - Attend two in-person conferences and Zone 4 meetings (advocacy conference in March and July principals conference).
- Travel costs are covered first by NAESP for national travel and by FASA/FAEMSP within reimbursement guidelines for board meetings and conferences.
