Oversees and directs the academic, administrative, financial, and public relations functions for the Lake Erie College of Osteopathic Medicine (LECOM) Bradenton Clinical Education program including the supervision of Bradenton COM Regional Deans.

Minimum Qualifications:

Education and experience equivalent to: an earned Degree as Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine (D.O.) from a COCA accredited college of osteopathic medicine or an earned degree as a Doctor of Medicine (M.D.) from an LCME accredited college of medicine. Candidate must be board certified and licensed or eligible for a current license to practice medicine. Five years of experience in academic administration and medical education at the level of Assistant Dean, Department Chair, Director of Medical Education, and/or Residency Program Director is preferred.
