## AOA Category 1A Credit for Formal Teaching:

Formal delivery of medical education lectures in the following settings: osteopathic and allopathic medical colleges, at specialty or divisional society conferences, to students, interns, residents, fellows, and staff.

- 1. Granted on an hour-for-hour basis
- 2. Must be verified by the CME Department of the medical college, sponsoring hospital, or sponsor.
- 3. To report CME earned by medical teaching, please submit a letter from the institution stating the number of hours and date(s) to receive credit. CME credits will not be awarded for preparation of lectures.

## AOA Category 1B Credit for GME Faculty/Preceptors:

Serving as GME faculty, GME core faculty, or preceptors in any AOAapproved osteopathic or ACGME-accredited graduate medical education.

- 1. Granted on an hour-for-hour basis A maximum of 20% of the required CME credits per 3-year AOA CME cycle may be earned for this activity.
- 2. No credit is available for precepting physician assistants or nurse practitioners.
- 3. If CME for GME Faculty/Precepting is not reported directly by the sponsor, please submit a letter from the institution stating the number of hours and date(s) to receive credit.
