CALL TO ORDER & PRESIDENT'S REPORT

President Jennifer Thoroe called the meeting to order at 12:01 pm.

President Thoroe welcomed everyone to the meeting. She noted that IADD had held the first Odyssey Expo since 2019 and continued to make progress on other meetings and goals, like in-person 101 workshops. Although there are challenges with members having enough time to volunteer and seeking engagement in new ways, the aim is to continue with strategic conversations and planning.

ACTION ITEM - Minutes

Due to a technical issue during the in-person meeting, the following approval was subsequently handled via email by all members in attendance at the September 21 meeting.

Mr. Darrel Griffin moved to approve the minutes from the October 27, 2022 Business Meeting, Mr. Rob McCann seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

PRESIDENT-ELECT'S REPORT

President-Elect Rob McCann described his primary goals for his upcoming presidency, including building upon progress made during President Thoroe's tenure. He affirmed there is much working well for IADD, including the technical content and access provided, yet acknowledged the need for further change and growth to meet members' current needs. President-Elect McCann championed the room full of passionate people who can continue to help get the message out.

CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER'S REPORT

CEO Jenny Holliday expressed appreciation for everyone's contributions. She then reported on staffing and orientations before providing a live demonstration of IADD's new website and online Resource Library.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Treasurer Darrel Griffin detailed the current financial status, including the fiscal year 2022-2023 loss the Association had. Although this was mostly in line with budgetary projections, he noted membership dues were down 3% and subscriptions down over 7% in a time when IADD had additional staffing expenses in order to successfully hold Odyssey Expo. The show itself brought in less revenue than previously but considering it was the first one in four years and without a cosponsor, it was felt to be a valuable experience for those who participated and a good benchmark for the future.

ACTION ITEM - Nominating Committee

Nominating Committee Chair Gino Gualtieri thanked everyone and introduced this year's Nominating Committee: Jeremy Guest, Mike Dailey, Darrel Griffin, and Greg Faddis. He reminded members that the IADD Bylaws provide three ways to nominate: 1) at the Annual Business Meeting, 2) by mail (which must be postmarked by 1/31/25), and 3) by the Nominating Committee.

Mr. Gualtieri noted that the bylaws grant authority to the Board to appoint one of the Directors and that this year the Board chose not to exercise this option. He reminded everyone that someone must have served on the Board for one year to be eligible for an officer position.

Mr. Andrew Carey moved that the nomination process be opened, Mr. Derrick Ames seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Jim Cincinello moved to accept the slate, Mr. David Bialoglow seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Andrew Carey moved to accept nominations from the floor, Mr. Rob McCann seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

Upon hearing no other names added to the slate, Mr. Andrew Carey moved that the nominations be closed, Mr. Brent Stephens seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

No new business was presented.

ADJOURN

There being no further business, Mr. Derrick Ames moved to adjourn the meeting, Mr. Andrew Carey seconded, the motion carried unanimously, and the meeting adjourned at 12:45 pm.

IADD NOMINATIONS: YOU CAN SHAPE THE FUTURE

The IADD strives to set even higher standards of service that enable us to improve your membership experience on every level. One of the ways you can influence this change is to thoughtfully select those members who will serve as the IADD's leadership.

On Tuesday, October 22, 2024, at the IADD Annual Business Meeting, voting members of the Association will nominate those persons they feel are most qualified to lead the Association forward. The Officer positions which will be open for nomination for the 2025/26 Association year are: Vice President-Education (two-year term), Vice President-Membership (two-year term) and Vice President-Technical Services (two-year term). In addition, four Board Director positions (three-year terms) will be open representing the areas of: Central Big 6 & Rocky Mountain Chapters, Membership Engagement, Education and Sales & Marketing.

According to the IADD Bylaws, members in these positions represent your interests when answering questions such as who our Association serves, how it serves them, where we are going, how we are going to get there, what resources do we have or need, what is our budget, what industry changes will impact our members, what additional opportunities might we seek out, etc. In addition to nominating qualified candidates, keep in mind that the composition of the Board should reflect our membership at large. Therefore, you will want to nominate representatives from all categories of the industry (diecutters, diemakers, suppliers) as well as ensuring other types of diversity in your leadership.
