FORMAT: 4 PERSON SCRAMBLE

- Men play from the **White Tees**. Women play from the **Red Tees**.
- All four players hit their own ball from the tee box. The players decide which drive is the best and select that spot to hit from.
- All four players then play the next shot from the position of the selected ball, placing their ball within **ONE CLUB LENGTH** of the spot.
- The ball must be hit from the same condition that it came to rest. Example: A ball in the rough must stay in the rough.
- If a selected ball is in a hazard (bunker), all balls must be played from within the hazard (players may rake between shots).
- On the putting green, all balls must be placed on the spot where the selected ball came to rest.
- **If a team only has three players:** they each shall play a 2nd ball on six of the holes, in rotation. For example, Player A plays 2 balls on Hole #1, player B plays 2 balls on Hole #2, Player C plays 2 balls on Hole #3 and repeat the rotation through the last hole.
- The first player listed on the scorecard is the team captain.
