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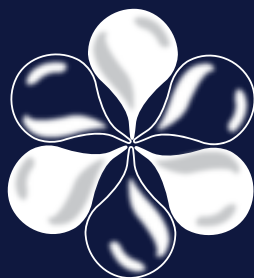

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CAN YOU SEE YOUR SHADOW?

As you read the title of this article, you may be asking yourself, “why is this guy writing about a groundhog,” or “how does he know I ate way too much over the holidays?” I can assure you that this article has nothing to do with either of those topics and everything to do with succession planning. You see, in each of our organizations, there are individuals that are waiting to be mentored into future leaders. The issue is that sometimes those individuals may be standing in the shadows and unsure of themselves. They may just need a little something to get them to realize their potential. So, the question is, can you see who those people are, and if so, what are you doing to help them grow personally and professionally to develop into a leader?

Succession planning is essentially about helping staff identify their true potential and understand their roles in the organization's future. The first step in this process is dedicating time for one-on-one meetings to work closely with staff in preparing individual development plans. In these sessions, setting expectations for professional growth is essential, as is honest and specific praise of acknowledgement when goals are achieved. There needs to be a sense of urgency when developing these plans. Cultivating positive energy with encouragement and setting clear expectations will ultimately yield growth and confidence in your team. If your staff is involved in the succession planning process, they are also more engaged in their daily work and more likely to feel invested in their company and its future.

One tool that is useful in helping create staff development plans is a SWOT Analysis. SWOT is an acronym for



Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, and Threats. The great thing about the SWOT Analysis is that it applies to organizational operations and individual growth plans for your team members. By having team members complete a SWOT Analysis, you are empowering them to be honest with themselves in terms of their strengths and, more importantly, their weaknesses. This allows the individual to identify what could be an opportunity for them to develop and where the threat might be in their growth model that could keep them from achieving their goals.

Another tool that is useful in helping set up development plans is the GROW Model. GROW stands for Goals, Reality, Options, and Way Forward/Will, and it helps identify specific areas for achievement and encourages the team member to design ways to achieve the goals they set. While similar to the SWOT, the GROW Model goes a step further and commits the employee to identifying and following through with their desired skill improvements.

Both of these models require effort and dedication from management. It is imperative that, as a manager, you listen to what your staff is telling you, and you empower them to contribute to their own success as well as the

organization's success. Challenging your staff with roles of greater responsibility to test their skills and reviewing the outcomes of the situations will be critical to their growth. Being a mentor yourself or identifying a mentor for them as a sounding board will help get them to understand and see their potential.

The Section is also a great resource for training and succession planning. First and foremost, the Section offers a variety of wide-ranging training opportunities that can help develop leadership traits and soft skills. Beyond that, just getting involved in the Section on a Council or Committee will also help develop skills and engage peers within the section. This is something our Young Professionals do a great job with.

As the remaining baby boomers in the water workforce rapidly approach retirement, it is critical that we have plans in place to fill those important positions. Preparing our staff with the skills needed to handle operational emergencies, financial decisions, engineering dilemmas, and even political inquiries will be critical to the long-term sustainability of the water industry. So, as you go into your next team meeting, ask yourself if you have succession plans for critical positions. If you don't, it might be time to start looking for your shadow and preparing it for the future. 💧

In other news, AWWA's Water 2050 initiative seeks to establish a long-term vision of the future of water. As part of this endeavor, I was invited to participate in the third of five 'Think Tanks' associated with the American Water Works Association's (AWWA) Water 2050 initiative.

Our topic was Economic Drivers. We gathered in New York City from January 23-25, 2023, and over three days, we envisioned the transformations needed to forge a resilient, equitable, and effective water sector by 2050.

In late 2022, two other 'Think Tanks' were held to visualize the future of water through the additional drivers of sustainability and technology. In addition, two further 'Think Tanks' on governance and social/demographics will be held this spring.

High-level recommendations, action steps, and insights will be reported after each 'Think Tank,' and after all five are completed, the reports will be combined into a final comprehensive report. Some of the guidance will be shared at ACE23 in Toronto to support the water community in realizing the Water 2050 vision.

"The aspirational insights and recommendations that emerge from the collaborative work around Water 2050 will drive AWWA's business plans and significantly influence our upcoming 2030 Strategic Plan," remarked AWWA Chief Executive Officer David LaFrance.

Inspiration for the Water 2050 initiative stems from an October 2021 discussion by the AWWA Board of Directors about what the water sector might look like in 2050 and was officially launched during an opening session at ACE22



in San Antonio, Texas. A video sharing reflections about the future of water and the challenges ahead from the perspectives of young professionals was also introduced. The resulting reports and video can be found at www.awwa.org/resources-tools/water-2050.

Ultimately, Water 2050 is intended to ripple beyond the water community, fostering partnerships, and cross-sector collaboration for mutual and global benefit. 💧

And together, we will not only continue to provide clean, safe water to our communities, but we will craft a smarter, more sustainable environment in which to do so. 💧



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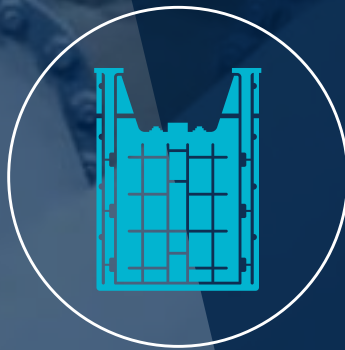
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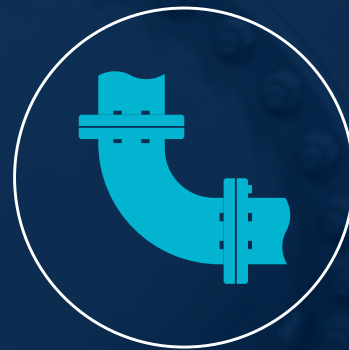

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WATER WARRIORS:

TEAMS ON THE FRONTLINE OF WATER QUALITY

As the old saying goes, “teamwork makes the dream work.” As cliché as that may sound, the spirit of the phrase is deeply rooted in an understanding that much more is possible when people work together. If you consider the challenges that the water sector faces on a daily basis, you have to appreciate the level of collaboration that goes into even the most routine of tasks.

But as we know, there is really no such thing as ‘routine’ when you are talking about the health and safety of an entire community or an entire region. As our infrastructure ages, the risk of failure and, more importantly, the consequences of failure have made it even more crucial to maintain, repair, and enhance our drinking water and clean water systems.

When routine devolves into a full-on public health emergency in a matter of moments, every ounce of collaboration and teamwork has the potential to impact and, hopefully, safeguard our entire way of life in a way that very few may fully understand. That’s where you, water professionals of all sorts, come in to keep the lifeblood pumping to all of our homes and businesses.

As we explore teamwork in the water industry through the MI-AWWA Series, *Water Warriors: Teams on the Frontline of Water Quality*, we will highlight examples of how water professionals come together to address water quality emergencies, complex infrastructure challenges, and how cross-functional collaboration creates the most innovative and effective solutions to problems both large and small.

In the next issue, we will highlight the Great Lakes Water Authority’s emergency

response to a break in the largest transmission main in the regional system, a 120-inch diameter pipe which affected 23 communities and over 900,000 residents of Southeast Michigan. From the systems analytics teams who discovered anomalies in the data

that triggered an organization-wide response to the intergovernmental emergency management teams tasked with facilitating the logistics of such a massive undertaking, we will uncover the triumphs, the lessons learned, and the team dynamics that helped make the necessary repairs happen. 💧

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PIECES FROM THE PAST

HIGHLIGHTING Water Systems in Michigan in 1973

Fifty years is a long time. At least, that is what I thought when I was much younger. Now I look back on fifty years, and it seems to have flown by in a flash. Even within the water industry, the current state of the industry doesn't seem all that different from the industry fifty years ago. Let's look back at 1973 and some of the highlights in the water systems in Michigan from that time.

In 1973, the Michigan Section hosted its Annual Conference in Grand Rapids, Michigan, at the Pantlind Hotel. I don't recognize many names from the program for that conference other than the Chair of the Ladies Committee – Patsy Clark. Sorry, Patsy, for outing you on your age!

Also in the news in 1973 was the problem of contaminated water. Estimates at that time indicated that nearly 23 million Americans were potentially drinking water that violated federal safety standards. In Duluth, Minnesota, asbestos fibers were discovered in their tap water. Even Dade County, Florida, was hit with a typhoid outbreak because of sewage in their drinking water. Luckily, here in Michigan, we had members like Gerald Remus as the General Manager of the Metropolitan Water System of Detroit, who ensured that the drinking water was of the highest quality. A tradition that is carried on today with the Great Lakes Water Authority and other utilities in Michigan.

What else happened in the water industry in Michigan in 1973? In Adrian, they were making plans to double the size of their water treatment plant. In Wakefield, they were addressing infrastructure issues when a water main sprung a leak that they could not find initially. This was not a small leak, either. It was calculated that over 200,000 gallons per day were leaking directly into the city sewer. This just goes to show that even fifty years ago, infrastructure issues were common.

In other news, the City of Royal Oak was trying to address its funding issues and had proposed a rate increase of 20%. This was necessary to finance new water mains, install outdoor meters, and pass on a rate increase from their wholesale supplier. In the City of Troy, they were planning for increased fees for builders for temporary construction permits. This only reminds us that we need to be mindful of the cost of producing and distributing water and that cost-of-service analyses and proper rate development are important to keeping our utilities running. Now we have added water affordability concerns to the mix to further complicate the matter.

We all know that safety is job one at most utilities, and our goal is to send everyone home at the end of the day the same way that they came in. Maybe a bit more tired, but overall healthy. Proper safety came to light in 1973 when three water workers in Troy were buried when a five-foot-tall embankment fell on them while they were repairing a broken water main. Luckily, two sustained only minor injuries, and the third was not hurt. A scary moment for sure.



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Remember this when you are taking your next trench safety course. Accidents can still happen if you don't do things the right way.

Of course, one of the biggest issues in 1973 in Michigan was the expansion of fluoridation of drinking water. In 1973, the issue was still front-page news even though the City of Grand Rapids began fluoridating its water supplies in 1945, and AWWA endorsed fluoridation in 1949. Detroit began fluoridating its water in 1967 to 90 different communities serving more than 3.8 million people. Things came to a head in 1973 when the City of Saginaw made plans to begin fluoridation. Bridgeport Township, which purchased its water from the Saginaw System, tried to pass an ordinance to block the fluoridation. Even though there have been numerous reports of the benefits of fluoridation, there are still critics of the process to this day. The fight goes on as to what should be in our drinking water and what should not.

In 1849, French writer Jean-Baptiste Alphonse Karr wrote, "Plus ça change, plus c'est la même chose," or "the more things change, the more they stay the same." As the world changes around us, we know that we must change as well. It just seems that even with all the changes that we have made, some of the issues within the industry are still with us today. I can only wonder what things will be like fifty years from now. 💧





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WHAT EVERY OPERATOR MUST KNOW

SPILL PREVENTION, CONTROL, AND COUNTERMEASURE (SPCC) PLANS

What is an SPCC?

SPCC plans were originally implemented in 1973 by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) (40CFR112.7) to protect navigable waters or adjoining shorelines from oil spills.

When do I need an SPCC Plan?

According to the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) Part 5, Rules that regulate the spillage of oil, SPCC plans apply to a facility that:

- Stores, transfers, uses, or consumes oil or oil products, such as diesel fuel, gasoline, lube oil, hydraulic oil, adjuvant oil, crop oil, vegetable oil, or animal fat; and

- Stores more than 1,320 US gallons in total of all aboveground containers (counting only containers with 55 gallons or greater storage capacity) or more than 42,000 gallons in completely buried containers; and
- Could reasonably be expected to discharge oil to navigable waters of the US or adjoining shorelines, such as lakes, rivers, and streams.
 - Determine this by considering the geography and location of your facility relative to nearby navigable waters (lakes, rivers, streams, creeks, etc.) or adjoining shorelines. Consider if ditches, gullies, storm sewers, or other drainage systems may transport any oil offsite and where. Estimate the volume of oil that could be spilled in an incident and how it might drain or flow from your facility, and the soil conditions or geographic features that might affect the flow toward navigable waters or adjoining shorelines.
 - Consider whether precipitation runoff could transport oil into navigable waters or adjoining shorelines. Manmade features such as dikes, equipment, or other structures that might prevent, contain, hinder, or restrain the flow of oil cannot be considered. Assume they are not present when making your determination. If you consider the applicable factors described above and determine that a spill can reasonably flow to a waterway, navigable water, or adjoining shorelines, you must comply with the SPCC rule.

What is in an SPCC Plan?

Like many emergency response plans, the SPCC plan should contain basic facility information and who to notify in case of a spill. The Plan will also have a detailed site map with spill control and cleanup procedures, precipitation management, and security procedures for the polluting materials in your facility. Updating your SPCC plan annually also helps remind you to check your spill kits and make sure everything is in working order.

A GLIMPSE AT COPPER COUNTRY WATER HISTORY

In this photo dated August 23, 1965, printed in the *Daily Mining Gazette* in Houghton, overlooking the village it serves, this 50,000-gallon capacity tank contains the pure and cool water of Gregory Springs. Upon completion of the project, Lake Linden will have one of the finest water systems in the Upper Peninsula.



Some years back, the Painesdale water tank (pictured undated) took on a grotesque appearance as it, through a leak, became arrayed as a near-huge stalactite stalagmite. The spectacle happened through a mere miniature leak which grew into an icicle of vast proportions.



In this undated photo, a water tower is seen in Calumet, Michigan. The DSS&A Depot is in the background, and the steeple of St. Mary's Catholic church peeks over the trestle. A water tower stands by the railroad tracks.



In this photo from November 12, 1905, a woman sits watching the pump at the Calumet & Hecla Waterworks Pump Building. A dog is sitting on the floor next to her, and three children are standing on the stairs.



In this photo from 1945, the photographer takes a photo of the exterior view of the pump station and boiler house at C&H Waterworks.



In 1925, the view overlooking Limerick, a Quincy Hill neighborhood, is pictured. Fences are prominent in the yards, and a 1920s-era automobile appears on the road. Several Sears-Roebuck houses are in the middle, and the water tower is visible center-right.



In this photo taken June 17, 1976, titled "Death of a Landmark," demolition work was started late last week on the old Baraga Water and Electric Building, which had been a part of the village since 1912. Replaced by a modern water plant a few years back, the building was deemed to have outlived its usefulness and was condemned by the village council a few months ago. The image is of the rundown building about to be destroyed.



The Redridge Community's water supply came from a pump at the Baltic Mill. Here Henry Hiltunen and his son Earl attend the pump. Water came from an artesian well in the hillside nearby. Though the mill closed in 1922, Copper Range supplied water free to all residents till 1962. A fire pump in the boiler house supplied high-pressure water from the steel dam to fight fires but through the same pipeline. Date of Photo: 1960-1970.

Raymond J. Faust Award

This award recognizes one or more individuals for outstanding personal

service in the water supply field. The award commemorates Raymond J. Faust for his contributions to safe public health engineering practices, his advancement of sound water supplies, and his dedication to building and promoting the waterworks industry of high esteem.

Chuck Van Der Kolk Volunteer of the Year Award

This award recognizes an individual for voluntary contributions to the Section through one or more of the following: interaction with a variety of groups (staff, councils, etc.), providing exceptional long-term service to the Section, performing a single action that has a large impact on the Section, or advancing the Section's mission through talent and service.

MI-AWWA Professional Excellence Awards

With the addition of the Excellence in Water Award, the Section looks to honor individuals, organizations, companies, project teams, or any other individual or group who made an exceptional contribution to the water industry. This award recognizes noteworthy efforts in protecting public health, promoting safe drinking water, innovative or creative ideas, outstanding leadership characteristics, promoting a diverse workforce, or operating seamlessly for their customers. Up to four awards (two individuals and two groups/organizations) will be given each year. There are no criteria for years of service.

Michigan Water Industry Hall of Fame

Research and Technical Practices Award

The Purpose of the Research and Technical Practices Award is to acknowledge outstanding research and technical practices, share research and technical practice findings among utilities, and encourage new research.

AWWA LEVEL AWARDS

Operator Meritorious Service Award

The Operator Meritorious Service Award recognizes individuals for special performance in one or more of the following areas: continuous compliance with public health standards in finished water; consistent and outstanding contribution to plant maintenance, thereby prolonging the useful life of

equipment; the development of new and/or modified equipment or significant process modifications to provide for a more efficient or effective treatment; special efforts in the training of treatment plant operators; special acts, not directly related to water treatment, but which demonstrate dedication to the public beyond the normal operating responsibilities; consistent and outstanding contribution to operation and/or maintenance of distribution lines, pump stations, and reservoirs.

George Warren Fuller Award

The George Warren Fuller Awards are presented annually by the American Water Works Association to the Sections' respective selected members for their distinguished service to the water supply field in commemoration of the sound engineering skill, the brilliant

diplomatic talent, and the constructive leadership that characterized the life of George Warren Fuller.

Exemplary Source Water Protection Award

The AWWA Exemplary Source Water Protection Program Award recognizes a public water system that has developed and implemented model source water protection programs. The drinking water supply sources must be associated with a water system or authority that is regulated by a federal/state/province/tribe government agency. The award applies to systems using surface water and/or groundwater as their source.

Wendell R. LaDue Safety Award

The award, established in honor of Wendell R. LaDue, is presented to recognize distinguished water utility safety programs. 💧

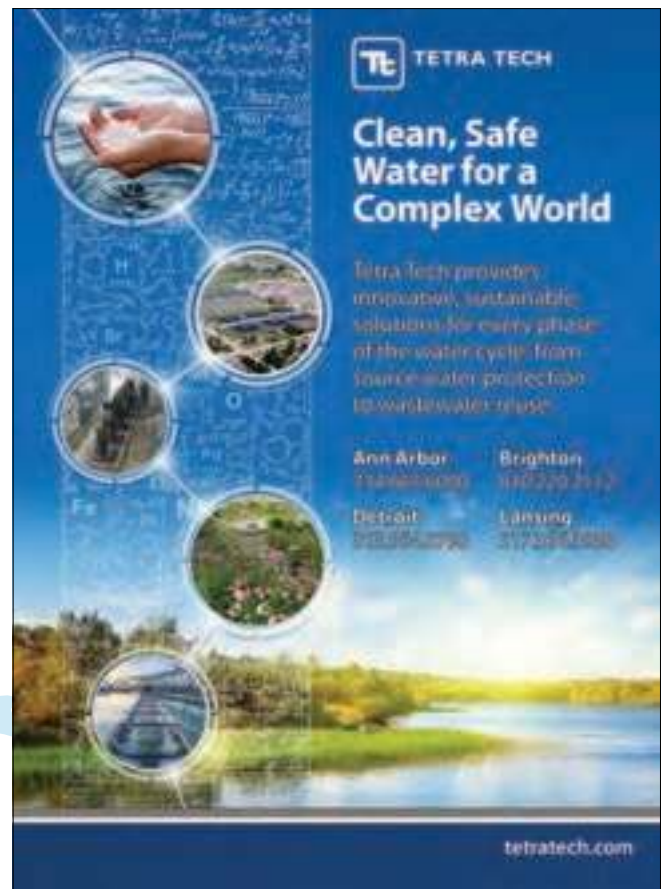
UPPER PENINSULA VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

Creating Equity Among Staff – this discussion will explore what equity is and how to foster it.

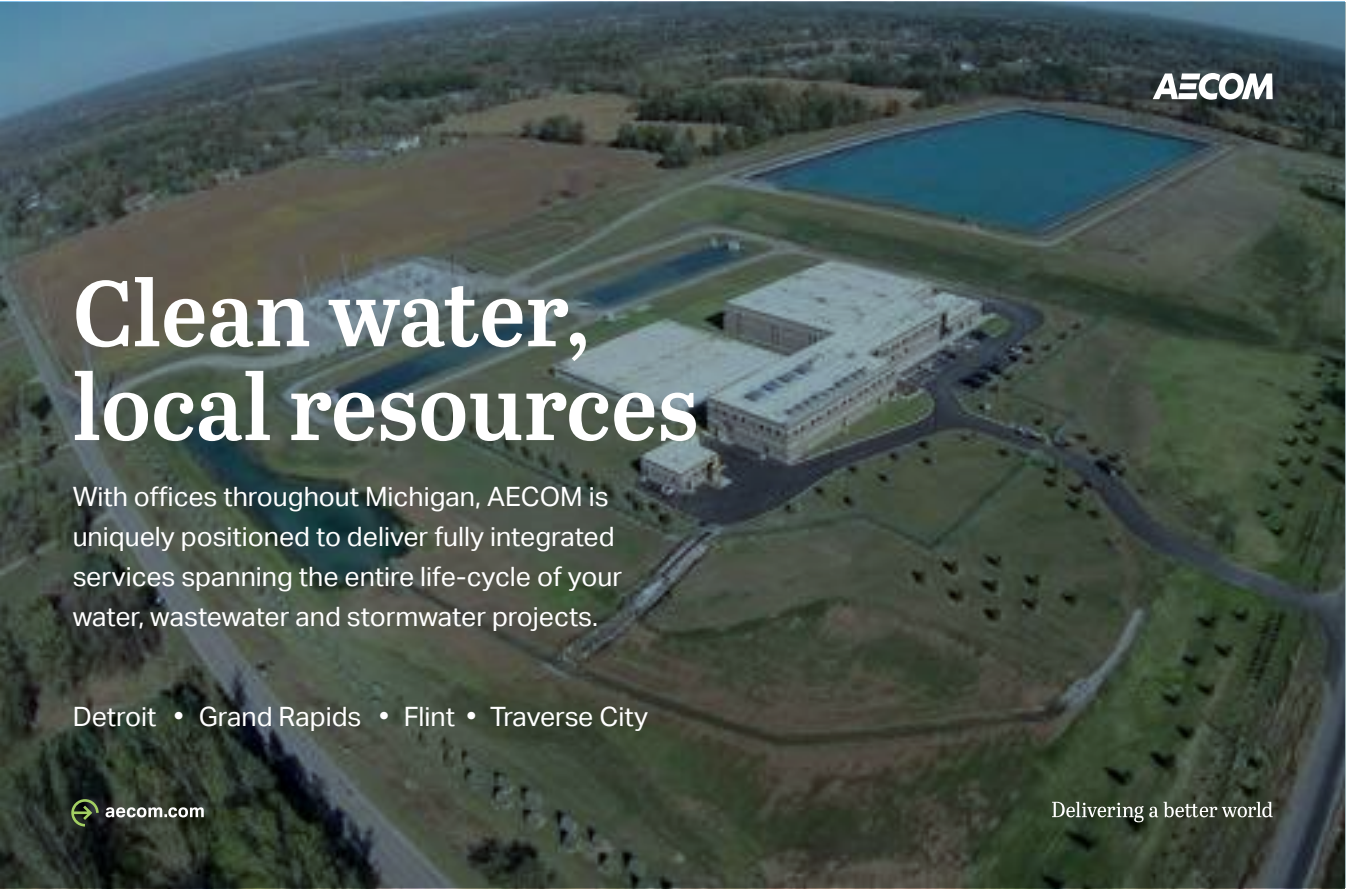

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DRINKING WATER WEEK

May 7-13, 2023

For more than 40 years, the American Water Works Association and its members have used Drinking Water Week as a unique opportunity for both water professionals and the communities they serve to recognize the vital role water plays in our daily lives.

Drinking Water Week is celebrated the first full week in May each year. In 1988, AWWA brought Drinking Water Week to the attention of the US Government and formed a coalition along with the League of Women Voters, the Association of State Drinking Water Administrators, and the US Environmental Protection Agency.

Rep. Robert Roe and Sen. Dennis DeConcini subsequently sponsored a resolution to name the first week of May as Drinking Water Week, and the week-long observance was declared in a joint congressional resolution signed by then-President Ronald Reagan.

POLICY PARTNERSHIP THRIVING

MI-AWWA has been partnering with MWEA for at least two decades, probably longer informally. Several years ago, the Boards decided to take the partnership to the next level by engaging a lobbyist together. MI-AWWA and MWEA have worked together with Midwest Strategy Group in Lansing on all things water policy related since.

This work has led to a number of positive outcomes, including:

- Prevented pipe materials being required in statute
- Revamped SRF scoring
- Helped to secure new infrastructure funds
- Increasing legislators understanding of water issues
- Guiding proposed water affordability legislation

During this past winter, leadership from MI-AWWA and MWEA had the chance to mingle with quadrant leaders and others at the State of the State reception. This was an opportunity for the association leaders to reintroduce themselves to the new leadership in Lansing ahead of the Joint Annual Hill Day.

The Joint Annual Hill Day is a day when members from both MI-AWWA and MWEA converge on Lansing to help advocate for policies that best serve the water and wastewater sector. The 2023 event is scheduled for April 12, 2023, and will likely have happened by the time you read this. Look for a recap on this year's Hill Day in the next issue! 💧





2023 MI-AWWA Fellowship for Water Quality and Treatment Research

The Michigan Section of American Water Works Association invites applications for fellowship study in areas related to water quality and treatment. The goals of this fellowship are to stimulate greater involvement of Michigan's academic institutions and their graduate and undergraduate students in the study of drinking water related fields and to encourage innovative solutions to priority problems of the drinking water community.

Applicants must be attending an accredited Michigan college or university and may be graduate or undergraduate students, as well as students admitted to graduate school.

Available Funds and Conditions

MI-AWWA offers two separate awards, one in the Undergraduate Fellowship Program and one in the Graduate Fellowship Program. Both programs are one year in length and each award provides a stipend to the student. An additional stipend will be transferred into a university account, to be used by the sponsoring professor for research-related expenses.

All applicants will also be awarded a one-year AWWA membership. Upon completion of the program, students are encouraged to submit a research paper or present their findings at an AWWA sponsored event.

Selection Process

The entries will be evaluated by the Research & Technical Practices Review Team. Selections will be made based on the merits of the proposed study as well as the applicant's academic achievements.

GOVERNMENT AFFAIRS COUNCIL

Matt Kennedy, Chair and John Willemin, Co-Chair

The Government Affairs Council, with input from the Board, has identified policy priorities for the current legislative session in Lansing. The priorities offer a framework for how MI-AWWA and its members will engage legislators and state agencies to improve operations for water utilities across Michigan.

- **Water Affordability** – There are a number of activities already happening in this area, including LIHWAP funding, data transparency, and the discussion of a statewide affordability program. MI-AWWA is engaged with legislators and other stakeholders to ensure water utilities' interests are represented as we work collaboratively to find a sustainable solution.
- **Operator Certification** – There has long been discussion about reciprocity, delays in receiving test results, and in-person vs. online testing.

MI-AWWA plans to engage EGLE in dialogue on these and other issues to offer context for why these issues are so critical to community water supplies.

- **Funding Process for Water Infrastructure** – We are enjoying a funding windfall, but the processes of getting that money to water supplies, together with supply chain and workforce issues, presents an untenable situation. MI-AWWA will be working with state legislators and EGLE on ways to improve the process and timing of DWSRF dollars.
- **Solids Disposal** – With emerging contaminants becoming a bigger issue in both water and wastewater treatment, disposal of solids is becoming an increasing problem. MI-AWWA will be working together with MWEA to engage legislators and

state officials in finding more effective and affordable options for solids disposal. EGLE efficiency, emerging contaminants, supply chain, and groundwater protection will be monitored throughout the year as well. The Government Affairs Council will work closely with the lobbying firm, Midwest Strategy Group, to ensure water systems' interests are represented in the legislative process.

These priorities will be highlighted during Hill Day, a day when water and wastewater professionals converge on Lansing to discuss our policy priorities with legislators. In addition, Michigan is sending four individuals to the Fly-In in Washington, DC. Thanks to Clow Valve for sponsoring two seats.

SOURCE WATER COMMITTEE UPDATE: SOURCE WATER PROTECTION PLAN

The Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA, also known as the "Bipartisan Infrastructure Law") has created new opportunities to complete water system improvement projects that many communities have talked about and dreamed about for years – or, dare we say, decades? Those big projects are the talk of the town! While our water treatment and distribution facilities have aged and are finally getting that new facelift they deserve, our communities have changed too, and something else might need some updating: Source Water Protection Plans (SWPP).

What is a Source Water Protection Plan?

The Source Water Protection Area defines the area from which groundwater or surface water contributes to the public water supply and identifies potential sources of water contamination within that area. It is a tool to document where potential threats to water quality are located so that communities may minimize the risk. It also defines roles and responsibilities in the community for implementing the SWPP.

Why Keep an SWPP Updated?

The more communities know about the potential risk to their surface water or groundwater supply sources, the better they can plan. The SWPP has a seven-step checklist:

1. **Roles and Responsibilities** – identify individuals responsible for the development, implementation, and long-term maintenance of the local SWPP.
2. **Source Water Protection Area Delineation** – determine that area which contributes water to a public water supply system (PWSS).
3. **Potential Sources of Contamination** – identify known and potential sites of contamination within the Wellhead Protection Area (WHPA) and list a contaminant inventory.
4. **Source Water Protection Area Management** – identify mechanisms to reduce the risk of existing and potential sources of contamination from reaching the public water supply.
5. **Contingency Plan** – develop an effective contingency plan in case of an emergency.
6. **New Wells/Sources** – provide information on existing groundwater availability, the ability of the PWSS to meet present and future demands, and the vulnerability of the existing wells or intakes to contamination.
7. **Public Education and Outreach** – generate community awareness in wellhead protection by focusing on public education about their wellhead protection area.

Does an SWPP Need Updating?

Everything changes with time.

Ask yourself this: Have community members who were heavily involved in the operations of the water distribution system and listed in the roles and responsibilities section of your plan retired? *Time to update!*

Has a well been taken offline, or has a new one been added? Has the intake location changed? If so, the recharge zone may have changed. *Time to update!*

Is there a new industry in town that might store chemicals outside? Alternatively, has an industry left that may have been listed in the SWPP? Are there any new environmental releases in your source water protection area? *Time to Update!*

Ultimately, the SWPP is a living document that should be reviewed annually. With all the changes occurring in the water industry of late, it would be no surprise if this one missed the to-do list!

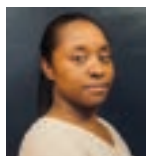

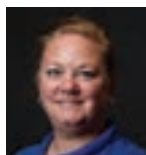

As Database Administrator, Chris ensures that all our data is as accurate as possible.

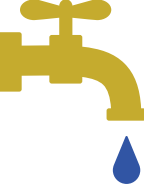

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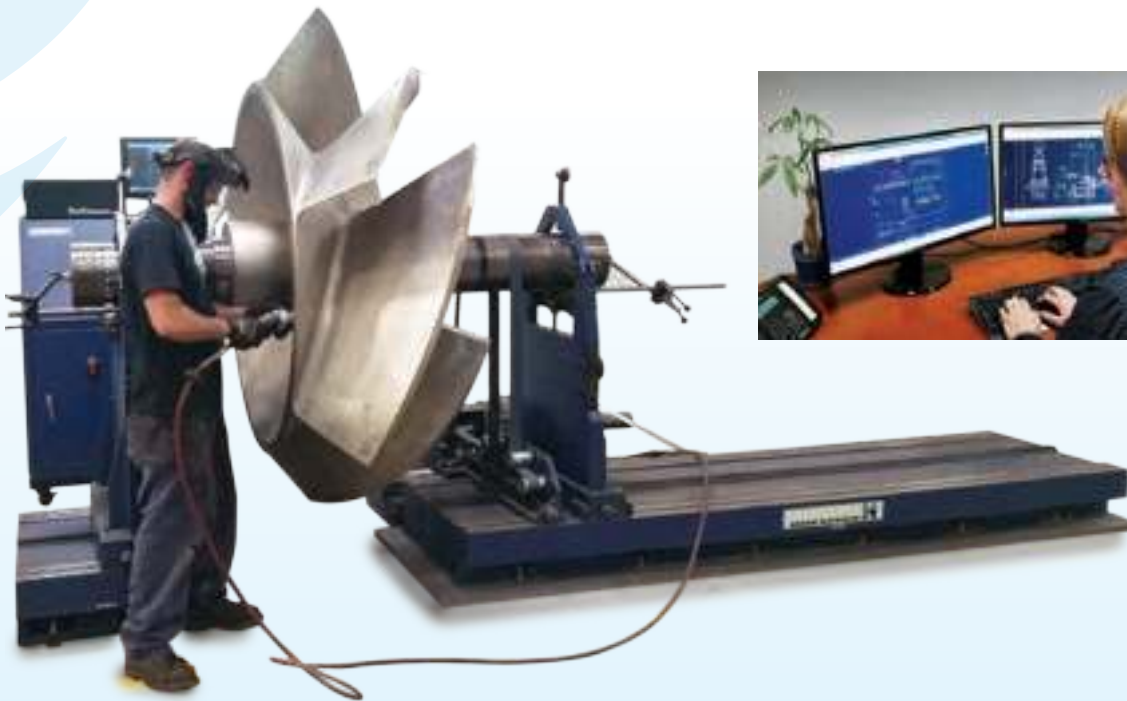
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CONSUMER CONFIDENCE REPORT

EGLE Drinking Water and Environmental Health Division



Each community water supply (CWS) is required to provide an annual water quality report to its customers. This annual water quality report is also referred to as the Consumer Confidence Report (CCR). CCRs are a great way for CWSs to communicate with their customers and raise awareness about the source and quality of their drinking water. The CCR also helps build the confidence and trust of their customers and to help protect public health.

Increasing customers' knowledge and understanding of their water system allows them to make informed decisions about reducing any potential risks and increases dialogue between the water utility and customers.

A CWS must deliver its CCR to customers, EGLE, and local health department by July 1 of each year.

It must also make a good-faith effort to deliver the CCR to consumers who do not directly pay water bills. A Certificate of Distribution must be submitted to the appropriate EGLE District Office by October 1 of each year. EGLE encourages supplies to submit the certification immediately after the CCR is distributed.

To help CWSs meet the CCR requirements, EGLE can review a draft of the CCR. If a CWS would like to have a draft of their CCR reviewed, they will need to submit a copy and request to their district office no later than June 1 of each year. EGLE reviews the CCR drafts in the order they are received. The review process can take up to two weeks, so CWSs should plan accordingly.

Note: Each year, EGLE updates and makes available a CCR template. It is important to use the current version

of the EGLE CCR template. Any changes to the content or instructions will be reflected in the current version. This will help avoid using old, outdated language or missing required content. Over the last couple of years, EGLE has found an increase in water supplies using older versions of this template. In some cases, the older versions lack updated content and can lead to missing required information.

OPERATOR TRAINING IN CYBERSECURITY AND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

According to a survey conducted by the American Water Works Association (AWWA) of over 20,000 utility employees, cyber threats were considered the biggest threat to operations, even before the pandemic. Emergency preparedness, along with training and prevention, is essential to avoiding a physical or cybersecurity attack that could threaten public health and safety. EGLE is helping water utilities be prepared for emergencies by supporting training and mutual aid networks.

Preparation for emergencies is key to reducing the response time when one occurs. The Federal Emergency Management Authority (FEMA) offers

several emergency preparedness courses about the incident command structure (ICS). EGLE has already approved four courses for CECs. Any operator can receive credit (don't forget to submit your certificate of completion) for taking the following courses: ICS 100, ICS 200, ICS 700, and ICS 800. These ICS courses are critical to exposing operators to the fundamental concepts of incident management response and should improve understanding of the command structure in the event one occurs.

Another tool that utilities can use in emergencies is mutual aid networks. The Michigan Water and Wastewater Agency Response Network (MiWARN) is a network of Utilities and Public Works

agencies within the state that have agreed to help other utilities respond to and recover from emergencies. Members of the MiWARN can help in the form of personnel aid, equipment, materials, and associated services to restore critical operations impacted during any type of emergency, big or small. Utilities, along with EGLE and other organizations in Michigan, are working to refresh and modernize the MiWARN network to help utilities with current challenges, such as supply chain issues and increase resiliency. 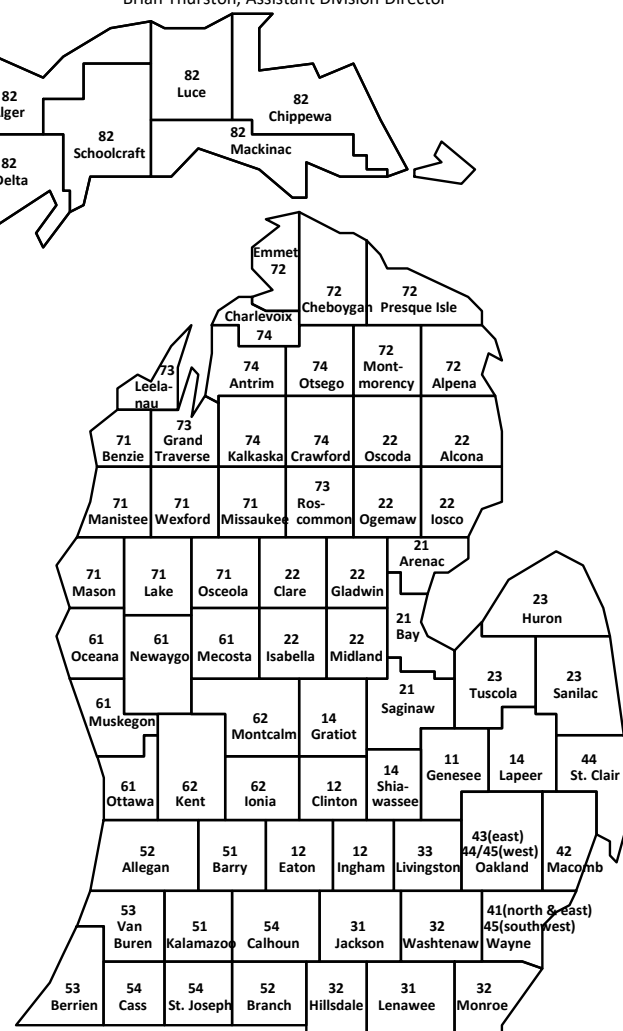

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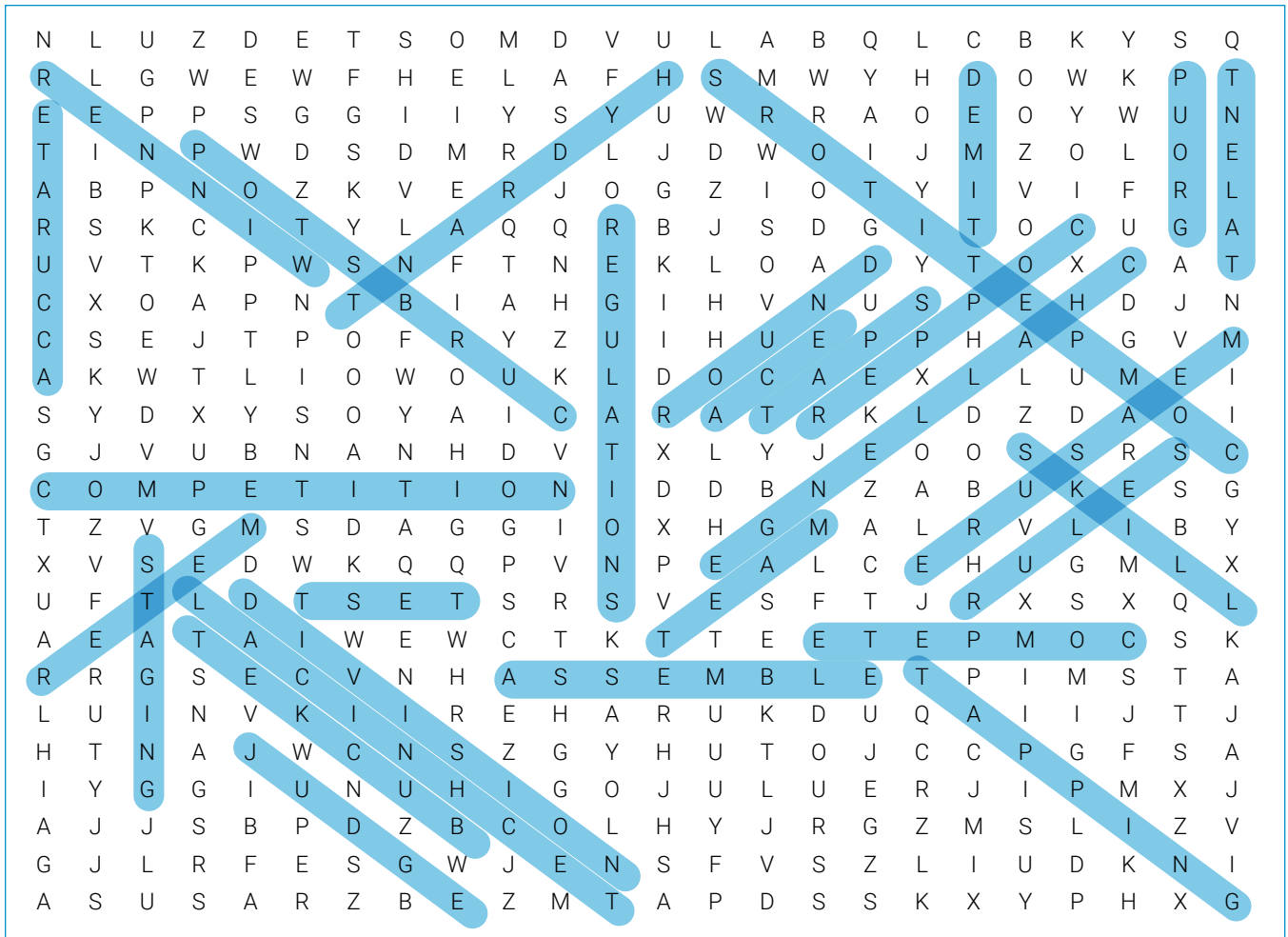
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
