- B. Agenda- Angie Goodman motioned to approve the agenda for the meeting.
- C. Approval of Minutes from December 11, 2024 meeting The meeting minutes of the December meeting were approved with a spelling correction made to the minutes.
- D. Committee Liaison Update.
