ELEVATING THE ISSUE OF WATER AFFORDABILITY

ater Affordability. What do you think of when you hear that phrase?' If I ask a number of different people that question, I am likely to get as many different answers. To some, it is about how we pay for treatment and distribution of water. Some will say it is about assistance programs for people experiencing economic stress or income inadequacy. And others center the conversation around human rights.

None of these answers is wrong, but none of them are singularly right, either. In order to build equitable and sustainable solutions and policies for water affordability, we must engage a diversity of voices and viewpoints. There are a number of groups addressing water affordability on different fronts – legislation, academic research, human services, asset management, environmental justice, payment assistance, rate setting, funding programs – but often these groups are working in parallel to one another. Sometimes, it can even feel like they are working in opposition.

Ideally, these would be efforts made in partnership with one another. Through our strategic discussions, the Section's board agreed MI-AWWA has an important role in facilitating the broad conversation about water affordability. Over the coming months, we will be elevating water affordability as a priority issue. The hope is to identify strategic partners to convene for a facilitated discussion with the goals of creating a shared understanding of the definition of water affordability, key areas of focus, and measurements of success. We will also be reaching out to our Section members for your input.


I encourage you to think about two questions:



PIECES FROM THE PAST

A CITY WATER Supply in 1896

The following article is an editorial taken from the St. Joseph Herald in 1896, recounting the history of the St. Joseph, MI, water supply from the manual collection of river water to a town pump and finally a Lake Michigan intake in 1892. It should be pointed out the town pump, in addition to being very shallow, was located close to the St. Joseph River with no treatment of any kind. The photograph was taken of the 1892 steam powered pumping station, which was replaced by a full treatment plant in 1931. The 1931 plant was decommissioned in 2020 with the SCIP (Strategic Capital Improvement Plan) Phase 1 improvements.



here was a time when the residents of St. Joseph drank nothing but water, but that was several years before the silver question became an

issue and is but a dim recollection in the minds of even the clearest headed members of our present populace.

There was a time when the residents of St. Joseph took turns carrying the gourd to the river and bringing it back full of sparkling water to quench their thirst and to use in the cooking of slap jacks or the brewing of family medicines. But that was a long time before Mayor Starr became a popocrat or before the town learned to know what a genuine comfort a mayor was. It was in the days that the hardy swain yanked the milk from the festive goat and the housewife cooked the same into delicious corn bread.

Well, the town grew, and a generation or two after, the carrying of the gourd to the river ceased to be an anticipated pleasure and it was decided by common consent of all the people to have a town pump. The well was



dug and the town took a holiday and put in the pump. The pump was made after a special order, complied, signed, sealed, and delivered by a committee of 10 trusted citizens.

The pump was a mammoth affair and began coming from the factory two months before the last piece arrived. It had laid corded up in back of the town hall until all of its numerous parts arrived, then the various parts were put together and as we have mentioned, the town took a day off and put in the pump. There were speeches by some of the leading lights of the town and singing of patriotic songs by the entire assemblage.

Then there was a scramble to get the first glass of water. A deacon of the Methodist church, the only man in town who could swear under his breath, and an able body of assistants reverently grasped the handle of the pump – and pumped. The man who by dint of muscle got the cup for the first drink, gulped down a pint of fluid which was a delightful mixture of oil, sand, grease, and earth gas, went home and was sick seven months with a delirium fever.

But after judicious legislation and the death of a few brave souls, confidence was restored and the policy of town pumpism grew steadily in public favor. A few public spirited citizens and leaders of fashion took to drinking pump water and the infant enterprise did business 24 hours a day and a side door business every Sunday.

The pump was located right at the present corner of State and Ship streets and was the cause of constant anxiety to the town authorities. It was constantly getting out of repair and there were only two men in town who could fix it. They were Joe Hagar and Joe Hone.

The old pump with its 40 feet of pipe used to be hauled out onto dry land about three times a week on the average and it came about that in later years the first item in the annual appropriation bill "THE MOST NAUSEATING LIQUID EVER CAME OUT OF THE GROUND WAS BROUGHT TO LIGHT BY THAT PUMP ... ONE MAN TRIED IT FOR CONSUMPTION. IT FIXED THE CONSUMPTION ALL RIGHT, FOR THE MAN DIED. THEN THE PUMP EXPERTS TOOK UP THE MACHINE AND FOUND THAT A RAT HAD CRAWLED INTO THE PIPE AND DIED."

of the town board would be, 'Repairs on the town pump. \$1,797.46.' But one day something happened that changed all this, and those readers who remember the occurrence will vouch for our veracity. The pump one morning began giving mineral water.

The most nauseating liquid ever came out of the ground was brought to light by that pump. But some men about town who had tasted mineral water said that this was thus and so it went out that we had an overflowing well of fine mineral water. Its healing propensities were great. One man tried it for consumption. It fixed the consumption all right, for the man died. Then the pump experts took up the machine and found that a rat had crawled into the pipe and died.

There was only one thing to do then and that was to have a water works. It was put to a vote and an overwhelming majority said that it should be built. I.W. Newcomer did a good job building the waterworks and today it stands as one of the most complete systems in Michigan. The water has been carefully tested and it would be difficult to get a purer liquid. It is taken a sufficient distance out in the lake to keep it pure and fresh.





Best Tasting Water in Michigan 2021:

A Return to Normalcy... Sort Of

Ilow me to get started by plagiarizing from my summer issue article from 2020: First and foremost, I hope this finds you, your family, friends, and coworkers healthy and safe. You see, it was about 10 months ago that I sat at my kitchen table, like I am

That brings us to the present. I am excited to announce, and look forward to administering, the 2021 Best Tasting Water in Michigan Taste-Off. The current plan is to hold the Regional competition at the Fall Regional Meetings. The State competition will be held at the 2022 Joint Expo. We are marginally confident these events will be able to proceed in person. So, make sure you dust off your mason jar, clean the plant tap, and start refining your secret recipe in preparation for 2021 Fall Regional Meetings. We will get back to our normal schedule in 2022 with the Regional Competition at the Spring Meetings and the State Competition at MI-ACE.

WHAT EVERY OPERATOR MUST KNOW (*) COMPREHENDING WATER CONTAMINANTS

hen most of us hear or read news about water, contaminants such as lead and PFAS are listed in varying units that are not easily understood. Lead is measured in ppb (parts per billion), while PFAS compounds are measured in ppt (parts per trillion), and chlorine residuals are measured in mg/L (milligrams per Liter) or ppm (parts per million). On top of it, metric units are difficult for many of us to comprehend.

At 4 degrees centigrade (39.2 F), one liter of water weighs one kilogram, which is the same as 1,000 grams or 1,000,000 milligrams. So, 1 mg/L and 1 ppm are one and the same. We can visualize or comprehend ppm in the following ways.

- Volumetrically, Delta Township water tank holds ½ million gallons and 1 gallon of water in that tank equates to 2 parts per million (ppm). The MSU water tank holds 2 million gallons and 1 gallon of water in that tank equates to 0.5 ppm. However, these tanks being up in the air, look much smaller from ground level and are hard to discern.
- Area-wise, an iPhone 12 in a football field (300' x 160') is the same as 2.35 ppm, or one-quarter dollar coin in a football field is the same as 0.1 ppm.
- Linearly, 1 inch in 16 miles or 1 second in 11.5 days is the same as 1 ppm.

When most of us hear or read news about water, contaminants such as lead and PFAS are listed in varying units that are not easily understood.

Some contaminant levels (eg. lead) are very small. In order to read them as whole numbers, we report them as parts per billion (ppb), which is 1,000 times smaller than ppm and equal to 1 microgram per liter.

- Size of 1 dime coin in a football field (300'x160') is the same as 56 ppb.
- 1 inch in 15,782 miles in the same as 1 ppb (eg. Los Angeles to New York is 2,800 miles)
- 1 second in nearly 32 years is the same as 1 ppb.

Contaminants levels (eg. PFAS compounds) that are 1,000 times smaller than ppb or 1,000,000 times smaller than ppm, are read as parts per trillion (ppt). We can visualize them as follows:

- 1 dime coin in 56 football fields is the same as 1 ppt.
- 1 second in 31,709 years is 1 ppt (Pyramids in Giza were built 4,500 years ago and don't start counting seconds!). ♦

Meet the UP EGLE Team



ARQUETTE – A little more than 390 miles from Lansing, located in the snowy terrain of Marquette, the Upper Peninsula EGLE District Office makes a home. Marquette is home to two offices of EGLE, the department that oversees the Community Water Supplies where Tom Flaminio is district supervisor, and the engineering unit, where Mike Bolf is engineering unit supervisor.

The Marquette District Office of EGLE Drinking Water and Environmental Health oversees 106 Community Water Supplies (CWS) in the UP that use groundwater for their source. According to Flaminio, a CWS is a supply that provides yearround service to 25 or more people or 15 or more living units.

"We administer the Environmental Protection Agency Program that sets minimum standards for safe drinking water as well as Michigan's *Safe Drinking Water Act*," he said. "There are 13 CWSs in the UP which use surface water and these are regulated by the EGLE Drinking Water Engineering Unit in Lansing."

One of the main activities in the Marquette District is completing a sanitary survey every three years for each water system. A sanitary survey evaluates the water systems capabilities to supply safe drinking water, and they complete about 36 each year, he said. "Every three years, we survey the water system, tanks, and wells, check water well chemistry," he said. "During the survey we assess the condition of the storage tanks, wells, and pumps to ensure they meet regulatory requirements. We also review operation and maintenance of the water system, reporting requirements, and management and financial aspects."

The department also competes routine site visits every six months for systems that treat their water, and every year for systems that do not treat water. During the visits, EGLE representatives meet with the water operators to discuss their operations and upcoming requirements or potential issues however, routine visits have been suspended during the COVID pandemic.

The department is also charged with reviewing and issuing construction permits for water systems for such projects as water main installation, new wells and tanks, and new chemical feeds. The laboratory results are reviewed of well and distribution samples to ensure compliance with regulatory limits. EGLE also reviews monthly operating reports – summarizing daily water use and chemical application – from the water systems.

"We also respond to water customer concerns and attend public meeting to address drinking water matters," Flaminio said.


Wolf supervises the engineering department and oversees a staff of 10. After the water issue in Flint occurred, EGLE reorganized and changed the way lead and copper is handled, he said.

"Around that same time, we created this engineering unit," Wolf said. "Surface systems are overseen by engineering specialists. We have three of those specialists and then there are junior engineers."

Larger surface unit plants are covered by Wolf's unit. He works indirectly with water municipalities, performing sanitary surveys required by EPA, also permitting, for new facilities and existing facilities and plants.

Within the last two years, all Lead and Copper program requirements have shifted to the Lead Copper Unit in Lansing. Their contacts are Brandon Onan (Supervisor) at *onanb@michigan.gov* and Jeni Bolt (Environmental Quality Specialist) at *boltj@michigan.gov*. The bacteriological sampling program is also run from Lansing, where the UP contact is John Karnes at *karnesj@michigan.gov*.

We also know we are surrounded by people and organizations going above and beyond for their customers, stakeholders, peers, and the public. Each year, the Michigan Section of AWWA celebrates and recognizes these accomplishments. The Section is seeking nominations for the following awards.

Take a moment to consider those you have interacted with that exemplify the best characteristics of professionalism in drinking water. Then, take another moment to visit the Michigan Section website to fill out the brief online nomination form to submit a person or an organization for an award. If you nominated someone or an organization in the past but they did not win, please submit it again for our consideration. Nominations are typically considered for two years, including self-nominations.

MI-AWWA Professional Excellence Awards

With the addition of the Excellence in Water award, the Section looks to honor individuals, organizations, companies, project teams, or any other individual or group who made an exceptional contribution to the water industry. This award recognizes noteworthy efforts in protecting public health, promoting safe drinking water, innovative or creative ideas, outstanding leadership characteristics, promoting a diverse workforce, or operating seamlessly for their customers.

Up to four awards (two individuals and two groups/organizations) will be given each year. There are no criteria for years of service.

Young Professional of the Year Award

The Michigan Section of AWWA Young Professional of the Year Award recognizes the contributions of young members, whose service and achievements are exceptional for their years of experience. The award is given annually to one member of the organization that has demonstrated an active commitment to the organization and the profession as a whole.

Raymond J. Faust Award

The award recognizes one or more individuals for outstanding personal service in the water supply field. The award commemorates Raymond J. Faust for his contributions to safe public health engineering practices, his advancement of sound water supplies, and his dedication to building and promoting the waterworks industry of high esteem.

Chuck Van Der Kolk Volunteer of the Year Award

GOVERNOR'S NEW \$500 MILLION CLEAN WATER PROPOSAL

As part of our ongoing legislative work in Lansing the Michigan Section of the American Water Works Association and Midwest Strategy Group have been working to secure funding for Governor Whitmer's new \$500 million clean water proposal.

As background, the MI Clean Water Plan was rolled out in late-2020 and is now an area that may be included in the upcoming FY21-22 legislative budget process. This funding is intended to be spread over the next several years and calls for creating a pool of funding from which local governments or utilities could apply for grants or loans to improve their water treatment systems.

These funds would draw on a variety of sources, including some existing unspent state dollars, federal funds, and unused portions of existing state-issued bonds. The plan does not require any tax increases. Some of these dollars will need legislative approval to be moved into new appropriations areas.

The plan would spend \$207.1 million on drinking water improvements, including replacing lead service lines in disadvantaged communities, removing PFAS chemicals, and treating water to meet state and federal standards for lead and copper.

An additional \$293 million for wastewater protection would fund grants for projects intended to prevent sewer overflows and discharges of raw sewage from surface or ground water, make use of green infrastructure, and eliminating failing septic systems.

There has been bipartisan interest in this new plan as comprehensive funding for improving drinking water and wastewater systems has been a need for years, particularly with new lead and copper service line requirements.

The team at Midwest Strategy Group will be working towards securing this new funding as we move through 2021. GOVERNMENT AFFAIRS COUNCIL

The Government Affairs Council and our lobbyist Midwest Strategy Group were monitoring a flurry of legislative activity at the end of the legislative session for the year, including the passage of two bills of note for our members:

SB 241: This bill prohibits water shutoffs due to non-payment and mandates that water services be restored to residences where shutoffs have occurred, in most circumstances, through March 31, 2021. This bill was sponsored by Senator Stephanie Chang, D-Detroit. The Governor signed the bill into law on December 22.

SB 1258: Among other things this legislation would allow is workers in essential industries like water and wastewater to remain on the job if exposed to COVID if they don't have symptoms. The Governor signed the bill into law on December 29. We are also talking with EGLE staff and monitoring the release of any guidance on the impact of the new federal Lead and Copper Rule. All we can say at this time is that the Michigan LCR is still in full effect and we do not expect anything in the federal rule (however it ultimately shakes out) to reduce the obligations you have under the current state rule.

Our annual Fly-In event will not be held in-person this year, but we will still be holding virtual meetings with Michigan's congressional representatives on April 19-20. This will present an opportunity to get more members involved in the event, and our goal is to get MI-AWWA members from each legislative district to participate this year, speaking to their own representatives about water issues. COMMUNICATIONS COUNCIL

The MI-AWWA Communications Council is planning to conduct its second virtual Media Training for the members in May. The AWWA Membership Summit was held virtually this year, which allowed several Michigan Section Membership Council members and Michigan Section Board members and staff to attend, along with over 100 other Membership Council and Committee attendees from all over the US and Canada. While it was not quite the same as attending in person, we did not have the weather-related travel delays often experienced in January.

We learned about how AWWA has been doing over the past year. Some take-aways are:

AWWA did have a net loss in membership, but not as much as it might have been due to the pandemic.

This past year ended with a total of around 49,500 members, a loss of about 2,700.

AWWA is working on some potential changes to Utility memberships that will make them simpler and more attractive to utilities. The goal for this year's membership count will be at least 50,000 members by the end of 2021.

We also heard many examples of what other Sections are doing to engage new members and Young Professionals. While some Sections had to cancel annual conferences due to the pandemic, many were able to hold virtual conferences, trainings, and networking events.



In addition to hearing presentations throughout the Summit, we got to participate in a virtual game designed by AWWA staff that mimicked the board game 'Life.' This game followed the life of AWWA members. It was entertaining and educational. Our own Carrie Ricker Cox was one of the winners!

The Michigan Section was one of nine sections that achieved the membership challenge goal for 2020. We retained 62% of first year individual members. Congratulations to all who assisted in this effort!



WHY IS LABORATORY CERTIFICATION IMPORTANT?



There are many labs to choose from for sample analysis. One of the decisions a water supply must make when having drinking water samples analyzed is, which lab should I use?

There are typically three main reasons why a customer selects a lab: quality, price and turnaround time. All three of these are important factors and the order of their importance may vary depending on your needs at the time. However, if you are having your samples analyzed in order to meet regulatory requirements under the *Safe Drinking Water Act* (SDWA), you must use a lab certified by the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE).

The main purpose for using a certified lab is that the data generated is of a known and defensible quality. The primary goal of the laboratory certification program is to ensure all labs in the program are generating consistent data. In other words, it should not matter what certified lab you are using, if the lab is following the requirements of the certification program, the data you receive should be very similar – regardless of the certified lab you use.


Accomplishing certification is no small task. All certified labs are audited every three years to ensure the data generated meets the quality control and quality assurance requirements of the program. In addition, labs must analyze Proficiency Test (PT) samples every year. PT samples are supplied by certified vendors and test the ability of the lab to properly perform an analysis. The lab must also conduct numerous quality control checks during the analysis, write up Standard Operating Procedures (SOP), and document everything they do to the extent they must even be able to trace reagents and standards used in an analysis based on the lot number. These are just some of the requirements certified labs must meet when analyzing sample for regulatory purposes under the SDWA.

You may wonder why we have been talking about the Michigan Water Academy[®] so much. The Academy[®] is actually designed to not only offer exceptional learning experiences for water professionals – it is also a great way for your community to succession plan. We've all heard of the silver tsunami. Some of you may already be experiencing this exodus of knowledge from your ranks. As people with 20 or more years in the water sector continue to retire, we need to take bold and creative action to fill the gaps in our workforce. One way is to strengthen those already here who can then step up to leadership positions. Another way is to recruit new people to the water sector. The Academy[®] is the perfect way to do both.

With its four levels, each community will be able to develop an individualized professional development plan for any of its water professionals, whether new to the industry or about to lead. Each class may earn college credit at Bay College. You may never have thought about getting an Associate degree from Bay since it's located in Escanaba.



But by earning credits through completion of Section trainings and the availability of online classes held by Bay, an associate's degree is now attainable.

We're in the throes of curriculum review and comparing what has been developed with the developing education program. All of this will come together to offer more and better opportunities to attract people to the water sector and help those already here to prepare for leadership position.

A good number of Academy[®] classes are expected to be available beginning in Fall 2021, with the full complement becoming available in 2022. ♦
