

MAPA Hot Mix Asphalt Hall of Fame – Award Description

Purpose

The Minnesota Asphalt Pavement Association (MAPA) Asphalt Hall of Fame honors individuals who have made significant and lasting contributions to the asphalt industry in Minnesota. This Hall of Fame is established to recognize leadership, innovation, and service to the asphalt paving community and to inspire future generations of industry professionals.



Who is Eligible

Individuals who have been active in Minnesota's Asphalt Industry, affiliated with asphalt producing and paving. Recognition may be based on a lifetime of achievement or a major milestone. Posthumous nominations will be accepted.

Selection Process

Nominations may be submitted at any time by any individual for consideration by the MAPA Asphalt Hall of Fame Selection Committee. The deadline for this year's nominations is Tuesday September 15th, 2026. Individuals approved by the Selection Committee (if living) and their nominators will be notified.

Induction

Individuals selected for the Hall of Fame will be inducted at the MAPA Annual Meeting. Each honoree will be recognized with an inscribed plaque and a permanent display in the MAPA Hot Mix Asphalt Hall of Fame area at the MAPA offices or at an appropriate industry venue.
