### **Privacy Policy**

GPI collects IP address/domain name combinations of users to the Web site, the electronic mail addresses of users who communicate with GPI via electronic mail, aggregate information on pages users access or visit, user-specific information on pages users access or visit and information volunteered by users.

We use tracking information to determine which areas of our site are most (and least) popular based on traffic to those areas. GPI does not track what individual users read, but rather how well each page performs overall. This helps us continue to build a better service for our users.
