1. President's Report

Dr. Patrick Ho

2. **CEO Report**

Cathy Stratton

- a. Staffing update: Cathy announced that Friday is Ava's last day with NHMS; she will be joining the AMA in Chicago in January. The Council members thanked her for her service and wished Ava success in her new role. Cathy is working on short and long term lobbyist solutions.
- b. Cathy reminded Council members that amended by-laws have been posted in the portal as well as minutes from the General Session at the recent Annual Meeting. Any who were not in attendance are encouraged to review them.
- c. The PA's are considering adding a member to the Council to the currently vacant seat

3. Legislative Update

Ava Hawkes

a. Ava presented an overview of the legislative process in NH, followed by a review of LSR's (placeholders for bills) that NHMS will likely want to follow in 2025. She flagged 140 LSRs ranging from anti-vaccine to reproductive health/abortion, licensing and public health. She cautioned that the legislature this year is strongly Republican with a super majority in the Senate, making it easier to override Vetoes. The Board and Legislative Committee will need to review the LSRs and decide where to focus and put resources. Session begins January 8th
