Matt Iseman is a Doctor turned Host, Comedian and Actor. Best known as the host of NBC's three-time Emmy Award-nominated hit competition series "American Ninja Warrior," which is aired its 16th season this past summer. He and his "ANW" co-host Akbar Gbajabiamila hosted the 2017 and 2018 "Macy's 4th of July Fireworks Spectacular," which aired on NBC. In 2018 and 2019, he also hosted History's "Evel Live," specials which honor legendary daredevil Evel Knievel. Having been Peacock's daytime host for the past three Olympic cycles, Matt returned for the 2024 Olympic Games in Paris as part of the game changing daytime show "Gold Zone."

His ongoing battle with Rheumatoid Arthritis transformed him into a strong supporter of the Arthritis Foundation, the charity he's represented while winning Celebrity Apprentice. Yes, Arnold Schwarzenegger considers him a celebrity. For his work over the past decade and a half, Matt was named the 2018 "Arthritis Warrior of the Year." And his battle with Renal Cell Carcinoma has made him a spokesperson for the American Cancer Society.

Dr. Matt was a regular on Hallmark's Home & Family, sharing his medical expertise and his unique lifestyle tips. His hosting has already earned him an Emmy Award on Clean House. He also hosted Sports Soup on Versus and Scream Play on E!. In addition to having fun on Lip Sync Battle, Hollywood Game Night, and Ellen's Game of Games, Matt has starred in countless commercials, numerous sitcoms and Transformers 2.
