Low Score = 0 to 3			
Moderate Score = 4 to 7			
High Score = $\geq 8$			

**NOTES**

- A score of  $<3$  indicates low risk
- A moderate risk score is 4 to 7
- High risk scores are  $\geq 8$
- The main drawback of the ORT is its susceptibility to deception.
