Hello everyone,

I saw nothing on the calendar at the beginning of the month, and I've checked back weekly but there is nothing listed. Please let me know if I'm mistaken.

There was a debit card transaction to 4Imprint in the amount of \$540.54 on 3/12/26. Was that an authorized transaction? If so, who can I contact to get a receipt for that expense?

There have been a large amount of phishing/spam/fraud emails coming into the ap@nmlta.org email. They look legitimate at first glance and are referencing board members authorizing accounts payable to pay invoices, mostly for business coaching and development services. Upon further inspection they are from multiple random email addresses, and I do not find the businesses online. They list that they are coming from a board member, but it is just the board members name, not their email address, which was one of the tip offs that they could be fraud. I have not paid any of these requests. Please let me know if I'm mistaken on this issue. Alissa, you sent me one on 4/10/26 that you thought you had received from Gricel, and I replied letting you know that I believed the invoices to be illegitimate, and that the invoice was not from Gricel, but those emails keep bouncing back whether I forward or click reply. Please be aware that this is happening and do not assume any emails coming to or from ap@nmlta.org are legitimate. Rob, is there anything you can do to filter these out? There may not be, but I thought it was worth asking. Please let me know if any of you have any legitimate payment requests that I have not responded to. I have nothing in my pending file.

I have sent the reports to the CPA for all three entities, and I have filed the annual report for the NMLTA on the NM Secretary of State's website. The Chili Currier and the PAC reports still need to be filed for this year. In year's past I have used the same board listing to file the PAC and the Chili Currier. Can I list the NMLTA board on the Chili Currier and PAC reports, since there is not a separate board of directors for either entity? The reports are due 5/15/26. Please get back to me as soon as possible on this issue.

I replied to an email Josh forwarded today about a late report regarding the PAC reporting to the NM Campaign Finance System. These reports are also filed with the NM Secretary of State, but another division and are not the same reports that I am referencing in the paragraph above. Because I must use a login that belongs to Josh Payne, I have not been trained in PAC reporting, the filing requirements have changed, I cannot ask questions because the login is not in my name, and because I don't even know what type of entity the PAC is, I am no longer comfortable filing the NM Campaign Finance reports. I would like to turn this task over to someone else. I can file the past due report with a \$10 discrepancy (there is no way for me to enter the \$10 in the new format because it is not a contribution) and request a waiver of the penalty. Someone else will need to file the report that is due on May 11th.
