Your activity in our Forum Communities is governed by the following requirements:

- All content and conversations within NMLTA Forum Communities must remain within the platform. Do not share posts or information externally, including on public forums or social media.
- Do not post confidential or sensitive information into the main feed or any group unless authorized and protected according to company policy.
- Be respectful to other members. Disagreements are acceptable, but must be conducted in a professional and constructive manner.
- Add value with each post and ensure your contributions are relevant to the organization's goals.
- You are responsible for the material you post to Engage. Ensure all content complies with company privacy and security policies.
- Messages should be brief, to the point, and substantiated when necessary.

Privacy and Security:

- Do not share personal data of others without consent.
- Report any suspected data breaches or inappropriate content immediately using the provided reporting link.
- Follow all company guidelines for protecting sensitive information and maintaining user privacy.

Consequences for Misuse:

Violations of this policy may result in removal of content, suspension of NMLTA Forum Community access, or further disciplinary action as deemed appropriate by the Board of Directors.
