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Sign Requirements for Public Pool Facilities

- The following requirements can be found in Title 24 of the California Building Code.
- Requirements apply to all new and existing public pool facilities effective September 1, 2012.
 Note: Public pool is defined as any public swimming pool, public bathhouse, public swimming place, and public bathing place that is or includes an artificial basin, chamber, or tank constructed or prefabricated with impermeable surfaces and such pools, bathhouses, and places are used or intended to be used for public swimming, diving, or recreational water activities. "Public Pool" does not include individual therapeutic tubs or baths where the main purpose is cleaning of the body.

The following signs are required:

All signs must have clearly legible letters or numbers not less than 4 inches (102 mm) high, (unless otherwise required). (3120B.1)

POOL CAPACITY A sign must indicate the maximum number of pool users permitted for each pool. (3120B.2) Note: -Capacity of a spa pool is based on one person for every 10 square feet of spa pool water surface area. -Capacity for all other pools is based on one person for every 20 square feet of pool water surface area. NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY Where no lifeguard service is provided a warning sign must be posted stating, "NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY." 911 The emergency telephone number 911 with numbers not less than 4 inches, the number of the nearest emergency services (Fire Department) and the name and street address of the pool facility with numbers and text not less than 1 inch must be posted. DIARRHEA A sign in letters at least 1 inch high and in a language or diagram which clearly states that persons having currently active diarrhea or who have had active diarrhea within the previous 14 days shall not be allowed to enter the pool water. (3120B.11)	Sign must be posted at the entrance area of a public pool. SPA WARNING A warning sign for spa pools must be posted stating, "CAUTION" and must include the following language in letters at least 1 inch high. (3120B.7): 1. Elderly persons, pregnant women, infants and those with health conditions requiring medical care should consult with a physician before entering the spa. 2. Unsupervised use by children under the age of 14 is prohibited. 3. Hot water immersion while under the influence of alcohol, narcotics, drugs, or medicines may lead to serious consequences and is not recommended. 4. Do not use alone. 5. Long exposure may result in hyperthermia, nausea, dizziness, or fainting.	Sign must be affixed to a wall, pole, gate, or similar permanent structure in a location visible to all spa users.	• Spas	ELDERIY PERSONS, PREGNANT WOMEN, INFANTS AND THOSE WITH HEALTH CONDITIONS I. EMERGENCY SHUT OFF Sign in letters at least one inch (25mm) high and stating, "EMERGENCY SHUT OFF SWITCH." (3120B.8)	Sign must be posted at the spa emergency shut off switch.	• Spas	EMERGENCY SHUT-OFF SWITCH
SPRAY GROUND Spray ground must have a sign posted that states, "CAUTION: WATER IS RECIRCULATED. DO NOT DRINK." (3120B.13)	Sign must be posted at each spray ground and be visible from any part of the spray ground.	• Spray Grounds	CAUTION: WATER IS RECIRCULATED DO NOT DRINK



Additional Signs May Be Required For:

KEYED GATES If pool enclosure has gates that require a key to exit, those gates and/or doors which will allow egress without a key must have a sign in letters at least 4 inches high stating EMERGENCY EXIT. (3119B.2 (3)) Note: -A pool enclosure must have at least one means of egress without a key for emergency purposes.	Sign must be posted on gates/doors where keyless egress is possible.	EMERGENCY
NO LIGHTS If pool was constructed without lighting or if lighting is inoperable, a sign must be posted stating, "NO USE OF POOL ALLOWED AFTER DARK." (3120B.9)	Sign must be posted at each pool entrance on the outside of the gate(s).	No Use of Pool Allowed After Dark

*Additional signs are required for wave pools & facilities using gaseous chlorine. Contact this Department for details.
