



## EVERYONE COUNTS.

**Everyone counts.** That means all Oklahomans. This year, the 2020 U.S. Census was one of the Oklahoma Center for Nonprofits' biggest priorities. A strong Census count helps our state receive federal funding for education, healthcare, human services and infrastructure. Our nonprofits answered the call.

Adam Soltani has been a strong voice in Oklahoma for equity and inclusion. His leadership at the Oklahoma Council on American-Islamic Relations has made an enormous impact on his own Muslim community and on Oklahoma as a whole. He knew the Census was important to our state, but he also knew that every Oklahoman - including the Okie Muslims - must be counted. Adam was an active member on the Oklahoma State Complete Count Committee, where Marnie Taylor served as a vice chair. He happily volunteered himself and others in his community to be a big part of the "OK, Let's Count" campaign led by our Department of Commerce. He rallied other nonprofits to join in the efforts. He ensured that minority voices were included in the count and the campaign. Because of his work, his community was counted - in a big way.

OKCNP also worked together with Michigan Nonprofit Association, inviting Donna Murray-Brown to Oklahoma to light the fire under our Census work. Along with the Oklahoma Institute of Child Advocacy and the Oklahoma Policy Institute (and with dozens of other nonprofits), **our sector prioritized the Census in a big way - despite the Pandemic and all of the other challenges before us.** That's working **TOGETHER.** With a voice that is to be counted. And heard.

Each person in Oklahoma accounts for \$1,675 per person per year in federal funding, for the next 10 years. Census data also informs funding and services for healthcare, education, infrastructure and more!

## THE INASMUCH FOUNDATION. AN INSPIRATIONAL COLLABORATION.

Last year, OKCNP worked extra closely with our friends at the Inasmuch Foundation in Oklahoma City. **As a long-time funding partner, the Foundation has invested heavily into our work with the Standards for Excellence, professional development training and consulting.**

Additionally, their support of our programs has been a game-changer for organizations throughout Central Oklahoma.

Our collaboration advanced in a big way with Senior Program Officer Sarah Roberts taking the helm of our annual Visions awards. **Her leadership, dedication and personal support for the programs at the Oklahoma Center for Nonprofits led Visions to a record year for fundraising.** The event itself was a spectacular success, with attendees raving that it was the “best ever.”

But the Foundation didn’t stop there. In April, at the height of the COVID-19 crisis, they approached us to help lead the way for making Small Business Administration loans available to nonprofits. **The consulting team at OKCNP received significant financial support from the Inasmuch Foundation** (along with several other funders leveraged by Mrs. Roberts) to spend 100% of their time walking hundreds of nonprofits throughout the state – particularly Central Oklahoma – to apply for and receive PPP and EIDL loans. Oklahoma was one of the top states for PPP loan receipt. Nonprofits reported to us that they received \$30.5 million in loans (that would later become grants). We estimate that nonprofits across the state probably brought in \$150 million in loans overall.



Each year, the Inasmuch Foundation sponsors a group of interns/fellows to loan to nonprofits. Bobby "Trae" Trousdale, a senior at OCU, spent his summer with OKCNP.



The Inasmuch Foundation helped OKCNP Member ReMerge from the beginning. Our own CEO Marnie Taylor served as board chair for a year, along with Sarah Roberts. Here is ReMerge celebrating the dedication of their new building.



The Inasmuch Foundation supports our consulting work, allowing us to offer strategic planning and other facilitation to nonprofits for reduced rates. Their gift helped support the strategic plan for the Oklahoma City Virtuosi.

As nonprofits started returning to offices in May and June, safety was key. Again, our collaboration with the Inasmuch Foundation led to a \$135,000 purchase and dispersal of protective equipment, such as masks, gloves and hand sanitizer, to 112 organizations in Central Oklahoma.

"We knew nonprofits needed the PPE," Roberts said in a video. "Who better to distribute than the Center!"

This collaboration is one for the record books, and OKCNP recognizes the hard work and generosity of the Inasmuch team, including Bob Ross, Sarah Roberts and the rest of the staff. It was with pride that we gave them our annual Community Partner of the Year award in June at our annual meeting, not surprisingly, via ZOOM.

Thank you, Sarah and Bob, along with your team. You are all about **Nonprofits Together.**

# WE RESPOND. TOGETHER.

When OKCNP received a call from Sarah Roberts, Senior Program Officer at The Inasmuch Foundation, we were thrilled to have a chance to partner with a number of foundations, corporations and individuals to help provide much needed Personal Protective Equipment for more than a hundred nonprofits in Central Oklahoma.

Sarah helped to gather a group of funders, raising more than \$125,000 to buy everything from gloves to sanitizer to masks and more. The Oklahoma Center for Nonprofits worked **TOGETHER** with the donors and our nonprofits to deliver thousands of pounds of PPE to various nonprofits.

This much-needed gift helped those nonprofits immensely. Our organizations had not budgeted safety equipment for a pandemic, but our philanthropists came in partnership to ease the burden in a big way.






