As Oklahoma's nonprofit association, OKCNP works tirelessly to protect and ensure our sector continues to thrive. Most recently, we provided information and resources to ensure organizations have access to American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding.

Throughout the past 40 years we have been fortunate to have partners like you. Your gifts support both OKCNP and professional development for Oklahoma's nonprofit sector. We call on your continued support as we position OKCNP to expand our services, advocate for nonprofits and build a stronger more vital sector in our next 40 years.

This semi-annual conference brought together nonprofits from both public charities and foundations, along with legal and financial professionals, to engage with the latest trends in nonprofit and foundation management. The 2021 conference featured leading local and national industry specialists, including featured keynote speakers Bruce R. Hopkins and Amelia Franck Meyer. Each of the 51 speakers presented current trends, research and policy, and networked with attendees through virtual discussion boards and speaker hangout sessions. Attendees included nonprofit executive directors, boards of directors, volunteers and staff members, as well as legal professionals, accountants and those in the finance industry.


PARTNERSHIPS

OKCNP continued to expand our capacity building network through two unique corporate partnership in 2020-2021. Through two separate gifts, one from BOK Financial and another from OG&E Energy Corp., OKCNP was given the chance to deliver impactful training for nonprofits on financial literacy and Standards for Excellence®.

BANK OF OKLAHOMA

Through our partnership with BOK Financial, we engaged 101 of their employees in Boot Camp for Boards training and delivered three financial literacy sessions, taught by BOK Financial executives, to 154 nonprofit professionals in the following courses:

- **Session 1:** Financial Sustainability for Nonprofits Protect: Knowing Risk and Managing It
- **Session 2:** Advise - Impact of Capital Markets on Our Financial Resources
- **Session 3:** Leveraging a Bank as a Financial Resource and Lending Partner



OG&E

In partnership with OG&E, OKCNP provided our flagship two-day Standards for Excellence® program free of charge to 36 nonprofit professionals representing 18 nonprofit organizations based in OG&E's service areas of Ada, Ardmore and Enid.

Immediate benefits to the participants of this project included a one-year membership to OKCNP, access to hundreds of sample documents and policy templates in key topic areas (including, but not limited to, social media, document retention, board governance and outcomes-based measurements), and a Standards for Excellence certificate of completion, which is valid for 5 years and includes recognition on the OKCNP website.

During the historic experience of the COVID-19 pandemic, Oklahoma nonprofits stepped up to keep their communities operating and their people taken care of. When the Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) became available, OKCNP helped nonprofits across the state gain access to those funds. \$478.4 million in PPP funding was dispersed to more than 3,300 Oklahoma nonprofits. As the pandemic continued to drag on, OKCNP worked with state officials to come up with additional aid, which will be available through funds from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA).


