Criteria

Reach and Inclusivity

The initiative impacts a broad range of individuals, with particular emphasis on underserved or marginalized populations. It addresses access disparities and promotes healthcare inclusivity within the community.

Positive Measurable Outcomes

Demonstrates measurable improvements in access to care, such as increased appointment availability, reduced barriers to entry, enhanced employee engagement, improved health literacy, or better community health indicators.

Sustainable and Long-Term Benefits

The project(s) is designed with sustainability in mind, ensuring that its positive effects will continue to benefit the community over time. This includes a plan for maintaining or expanding the impact, either independently or through partnerships.

Community and Stakeholder Engagement

Actively involves employees, community members, stakeholders, and/or local organizations in the planning, execution, and feedback processes. Shows responsiveness to community needs and encourages a collaborative, community-focused approach to access solutions.
