## **About this Session:**

### **Module 1.**

(90 minute presentation)

Active Assailant/Shooter Incidents are often unpredictable and evolve quickly. In the midst of the chaos, anyone can play an integral role in mitigating the impact of an active violent incident. The presentation topic, Response Techniques To An Active Assailant/Shooter Incident is a 60 minute lecture based training, providing a plan for individuals on how to respond to the threat of an aggressive intruder during an active assailant/shooter event.

The following are enabling objectives for this presentation:

1. Relate the definition of an active assailant/shooter incident;
2. Relate the difference between hostage and active assailant/shooter incidents;
3. Describe at least three survival techniques for an active assailant/shooter incident;
4. Describe what personal actions should be when police enter;
5. Relate the need for mental health intervention after experiencing this type of life altering event.

### **Module 2.**

(90 minute presentation)

Active Assailant/Shooter and Hostage related incidents are often unpredictable and evolve quickly. In the midst of the chaos, anyone can play an integral role in mitigating the impact of these life altering events.. Each incident type has a totally different nuance and requires an entirely different response from the innocent victims caught up in the violence.

The presentation topic, Response Techniques To An Active Assailant/Shooter Incident and Survival Techniques For Hostage Incidents is a 90 minute lecture based training, providing a plan for individuals on how to respond to the two totally different incidents.

Victims must understand their responses to each of these two different violent incidents are on the opposite end of the spectrum of victim responses.
