 - Candidates reestablishing eligibility for our exam system

FELLOWS & 2020 APPLIED EXAMS


- Fellows graduating in 2020 who registered to take a 2020 APPLIED Exam will be allowed to take their subspecialty exam in 2020 without first being certified in the specialty
- Their subspecialty exam results will be valid until Dec. 31, 2022, and will expire if they have not earned initial certification in anesthesiology by that date

- Programs will have the opportunity to administer the November BASIC Exam at their site (Nov. 13-14), but candidates may also take the exam at Pearson VUE testing centers

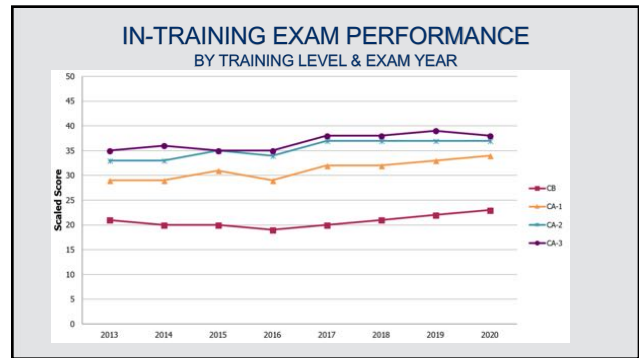

2020 MOCA REQUIREMENTS WAIVED

- Modified MOCA Minute algorithm to not penalize diplomates who are unable to answer all 120 questions this year
- All diplomates will have their status updated to "Participating in MOC" in January
 - Includes physicians with time-limited and non-time limited certificates
 - Physicians with expired certificates who are participating in MOCA to reestablish certification (MOCA Years 11-13) will be granted an additional year of MOCA participation to catch up on requirements but will not be updated to "Participating in MOC" in January

2020 MOCA REQUIREMENTS WAIVED

- Any unanswered 2020 MOCA Minute questions will not be counted as incorrect or lower diplomates' performance value
- Diplomates' 2021 MOCA Minute performance (MDT value) will be based on their 120 most recently answered questions, regardless of the year in which the questions were answered
- All other MOCA requirements are still due, but we are providing more time for diplomates to complete them
