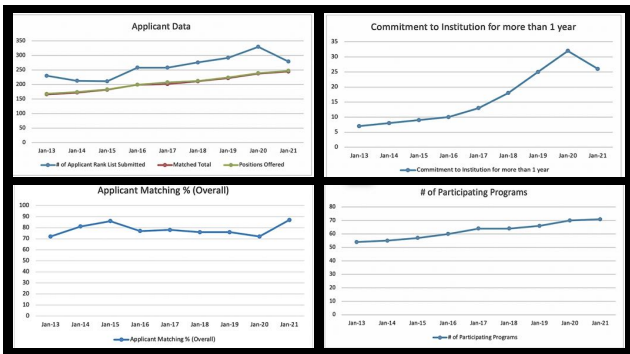

Dual Training in Adult Cardiothoracic Anesthesia and Critical Care Medicine Information for Applicants

General Information

Critical Care Medicine (CCM) and Adult Cardiothoracic Anesthesia (ACTA) are separate fellowship training programs. Unfortunately, in the current COVID environment, there is no real "hybrid" dual (CMACTA) dual clinical sites in which CCM and ACTA are combined. Existing programs typically offer a sequential fellowship training (parallel or not) followed by ACTA or a similar trainee to be eligible "trainee" for dual of training. These dual trainees with CCM and ACTA programs that work closely together will often operate that Fellowship very independently. This document serves to give applicants general guidance when applying to these programs that training.

Candidates who want to apply to both CCM and ACTA ("dual training") are entering a complex process that involving training on a single and career path. Both CCM and ACTA use the SF Match service for applications and to conduct the "match" which takes place in the spring. The CCM match takes a usually several weeks prior to the ACTA match date. There is no currently an integrated match process that would allow a candidate to seek both CCM and ACTA programs. Therefore, CCM and ACTA have an agreed upon "rotation period" based information on the CCM and ACTA websites for more information.

Candidates who do not receive an "rotation offer" will have to make a decision about their application and can usually only enter one of the two matches based on an ongoing deadline. There is great variability among programs in its ability to accept the entire process. The lack of an "rotation offer" from a specific program does not indicate that the program will not seek a candidate in the match.
