



Dave Davis Research in Continuing Medical Education Award

Criteria Last Updated: July 7, 2025

This award is given to an individual, or group of individuals, who have made sustained outstanding contributions to research in continuous professional development/continuing education (CPD/CE). The nominee must be a current SACME member, and it is recommended that the nominee be at least mid-career. Nominations must be submitted by the advertised deadline, along with the candidate's CV/Resume and the completion of the detailed nomination form by the nominator. Award criteria include the following:

Sustained Contribution

- Evidence of a long-term commitment to research in CPD/CE (e.g., 10+ years of scholarly activity).
- Active involvement in SACME activities and alignment with its mission.
- Advancement of scholarship and research in CPD/CE through active peer review of research grants and academic publications (e.g., JCEHP or relevant editorial boards).

Impact of Research

- Demonstrated influence on the field (e.g., citations, policy changes, practice improvements).
- Quality and quantity of peer-reviewed publications, presentations, and funded and non-funded research.

Innovation and Originality

- Novel approaches, frameworks, or methodologies introduced to CPD/CE research.

Leadership and Mentorship

- Contributions to mentoring others in CPD/CE research and leading research initiatives.
