



Excellence in Service to SACME Award

Criteria Last Updated: July 7, 2025

The award should be given to a SACME member who has made significant and sustained contributions to the organization over an extended period. This could include leadership roles, committee work, or other forms of active participation that have had a lasting impact on SACME. The nominee must be a current SACME member. Nominations must be submitted by the advertised deadline, along with the candidate's CV/Resume and the completion of the detailed nomination form by the nominator. Award criteria include the following:

Innovation in SACME Activities

- Individuals who have developed innovative programs, initiatives, or strategies within SACME that represent important advances in continuing professional development (CPD) or continuing education (CE). These innovations should have demonstrably improved the effectiveness or reach of SACME's educational offerings.

Mentorship and Support

- Individuals who have shown exceptional dedication to mentoring and supporting other SACME members, fostering a culture of collaboration and professional growth within the organization.

Advocacy for SACME's Mission

- Individuals who have been strong advocates for SACME's mission and values, both within the organization and in the broader medical education community. This could include efforts to promote the importance of CPD/CE and to raise awareness of SACME's contributions to the field.

Service Excellence

- Individuals who have consistently demonstrated excellence in service to SACME, going above and beyond in their volunteer roles and contributing to the organization's success through their dedication and hard work.
