Climate Collaborative Participation Agreements

Action Teams will meet regularly, probably every two weeks, and participants will do ‘homework’ between calls to keep discussions rich and progress moving. SPLC will provide administrative support, and our Technical lead partners will provide information about opportunities and support structured engagement with outside parties critical to enabling emissions reduction.

In addition to the formal supplier consultations expected as we move to finalize our work, we will ask and encourage all participants to be open to helping test or review proposals and work products in a confidential discussion with their own suppliers and procurement staff and to share suggestions and insights from those conversations with the group.

Beyond these specific roles and expectations, we will operate under basic agreements as follows:

- Observe Chatham House Rule in all meetings – no attribution of any specific statement or information to any identified individual without explicit permission from that party.
- Respect all Anti-Trust guidelines, which include no discussion of prices paid or received for products or services, no discussion of specific supplier financial engagements, and coordination only on high-level approaches and strategies related directly to achieving emissions reductions.
- Share internal insights and tools/methods to the greatest degree possible to aggregate knowledge and build toward meaningful shared understanding and approach.
- Deploy organizational resources (i.e., technical support, operational insights, testbed deployment of prototyped solutions) as fully as possible to sharpen and provide meaningful feedback on draft solutions and enable rapid iteration and improvement.
- Engage key allies and partners to join the Collaborative or support its work with data, in-kind service, financial, or other contributions.
