



SPR Nominating Committee

Consider influencing the future of the Society by running for election to serve as a member of the **SPR Nominating Committee**. Each year, the Nominating Committee is responsible for identifying eligible members in good standing to the Board of Directors as candidates for elected offices. Before putting your name forward or encouraging a fellow member to do so, please review the following:

- SPR Active, Allied, Emeritus, and Honorary Members are eligible for consideration.
- A person may only serve on the Nominating Committee once during their tenure as an SPR member. **Note:** the SPR Board Chair is exempt from this rule when serving as the committee chair. The SPR President is also exempt from this rule when serving as an ex-officio, non-voting committee member.
- Candidates from the same institution as the continuing **elected** Nominating Committee members (not including the chair or president) are **NOT** eligible for positions on the slate. This criterion is enforced to diversify the Nominating Committee and eliminate multiple recusals during deliberations. **View the Nominating Committee roster [here](#).**
- Candidates with five or more years of membership in the Society are preferred. This benchmark helps compose a Nominating Committee of members with Society knowledge.

SPR Ethics Committee

Are you interested in standing for consideration for election to the **SPR Ethics Committee**? One (1) elected member will be selected by you, the members, to serve a two-year term. - The current Ethics Committee members ([roster accessible here](#))
- Dr. Stephan Voss's first term will conclude on May 31, 2024. He is **eligible** for consideration for re-election.
- Members of the [SPR Board of Directors](#) and [Judiciary Committee](#) are **not** eligible to serve. **Exception:** Dr. Paul Guillerman's and Dr. Alex Towbin's terms as voting board members will conclude on May 31, 2024. Therefore, they are **eligible** for consideration.

Items to Note:

- There is one [interest form](#) for the Ethics and Nominating Committees. The submission deadline is **Monday, February 26th**.
- **Only the person willing to stand for consideration is to complete the interest form ([here](#)).** If you have a colleague in mind, please encourage them to complete the form.
- The elected members will be **required** to adhere to the rules and policies of the Society. Elected members of the Nominating Committee **must** participate in all meetings. Given the responsibility of the Nominating Committee, exceptions **cannot** be made.
