BOARD OF TRUSTEES

MEETING REPORT

February 21, 2026



The TDA Board of Trustees, chaired by TDA President Dr. Allen Burseson, met on February 21, 2026, via Zoom Video Conference. Below are the key actions and reports from the meeting.

Actions of the Board:

Fellowship Award: Approved a motion for the following to receive the 2026 Fellowship Award (district noted in parenthesis): Dr. Van Guthrie III (1), Dr. Matt Heaton (2), Dr. Robert Clark (3), Dr. Garrett Orr (4), Dr. Phillip Kemp (5), Dr. John Shea Jr. (5), Dr. Richard Robinette (6), Dr. Lance Culley (7), Dr. Keith Gilmore (8), Dr. Wes McCann (9), Dr. Micah Parkhurst (9)

Dr. Jack Wells Award: By confidential vote of the trustees, Dr. James Ragain, Memphis, was chosen to receive the 2026 Dr. Jack Wells Memorial Dedication to Dentistry award.

New Dentist Award: By confidential vote of the trustees, Dr. Lydia Lancaster, Nashville, was chosen to receive the 2026 New Dentist Impact Award.

Committee Appointments:

Approved appointments to committees and selected committee chairs to fill open positions beginning July 1, 2026.

Second District Name Change:

Approved a resolution from the Second District Dental Society to change their district's name to the Knoxville Area Dental Association. This resolution will be presented at the House of Delegates on May 9, 2026.

Governance Recommendations:

Approved a resolution from the Task Force on Strategic Plan 2.1 with recommendations for a framework to streamline governance, which will go to the House of Delegates May 9th for a vote.

Highlighted Reports:

Treasurer's Report:

Dr. Jay Davis, Treasurer, presented the unaudited financial report as of December 31, 2025.

Legislative Update regarding bills on anti-fluoridation, immigration, Rural Health Transformation funding, and scope of practice issues. A successful Day on the Hill, February 10th, was reported.

President-elect Report: President-elect Kevin Bryant expressed concern about the significant wellness challenges impacting dentists and presented data showing elevated suicide rates within the dental profession. Dr. Bryant aims to increase awareness of these issues and highlight available support resources.

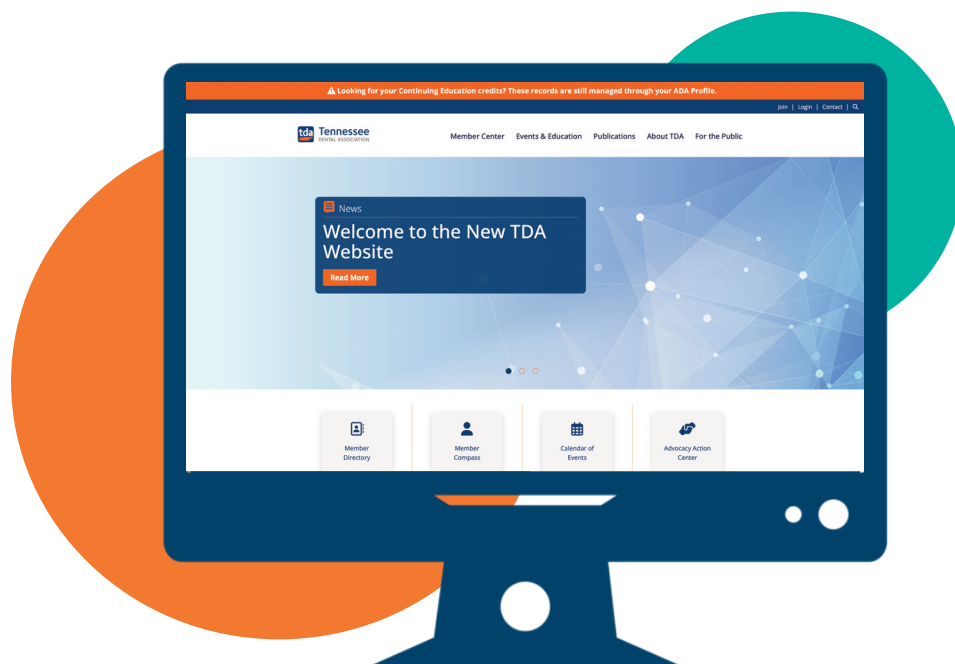

2026 LEGISLATIVE RECAP

THE POWER OF PRESENCE: FROM STRATEGIC ADVOCACY TO STATEWIDE IMPACT

The 2026 legislative session proved that when Tennessee dentists show up, the trajectory of public health policy changes. These legislative victories were the result of a multi-pronged strategy that began months before the first gavel fell, combining proactive education, technical workgroups, and a massive grassroots response.

Building the Foundation: Tennessee Dentists' Day on the Hill

The foundation for this year's success was laid during the third annual Tennessee Dentists' Day on the Hill. Member dentists from across the state traveled to Nashville to ensure the profession had a seat at the table before key votes were cast.

The impact of this in-person presence was undeniable. Member dentists canvassed 132 legislative offices and held 21 formal meetings, in addition to dozens of personally scheduled sessions. Beyond public health and scope of practice, our advocates drove meaningful dialogue around strengthening dental insurance reform enforcement. There was interest among legislators in enhancing reporting measures through the Tennessee Department of Commerce and Insurance to ensure that the 2024 dental insurance reform bill is being properly upheld for the benefit of both providers and patients.

Defending Community Water Fluoridation

The relationships solidified during Day on the Hill provided the leverage needed to protect the state's public health infrastructure. Anticipating a return of anti-fluoridation policy, the association used Day on the Hill to proactively educate lawmakers. Members utilized evidence-based resources that detailed the safety and proven efficacy of community water fluoridation (CWF).

This early education proved vital. Shortly after Day on the Hill, two anti-fluoridation bills—SB0162/HB2396 and HB2471/SB2304—began moving through the committee process. The TDA immediately launched a targeted grassroots response to ensure that the momentum from Day on the Hill translated into direct pressure on the Senate Energy, Agriculture, and Natural Resources Committee and the House Agriculture and Natural Resources Subcommittee.

To provide clinical expertise on the record, the TDA called upon Dr. Leon Stanislav and Executive Director Andrea Hayes to provide formal testimony. Their insights, combined with over 400 member emails, led to a significant victory: SB0162 was defeated by a single-vote margin, officially ending the bill for the year. Meanwhile, SB2304 was sidelined to General Subcommittee, removing it from the legislative calendar for the remainder of the session.



Navigating Scope of Practice

Presence at the Capitol also allowed the TDA to manage two distinct legislative tracks regarding dental hygiene scope of practice. The goal was to ensure any changes prioritized the team-based care model and patient safety.

The Consensus Approach: Since last September, a dedicated TDA workgroup has been engaging with the Tennessee Dental Hygienists' Association (TDHA) on HB1991/SB1926. This early collaboration allowed the TDA to guide the issue and provide timely feedback during the bill's development. Because of the workgroup's engagement, several problematic proposals were eliminated before the formal language was ever drafted. This consensus solution maintains appropriate clinical oversight while addressing workforce needs.

The Administration's Proposal: Simultaneously, the TDA monitored a separate push from the Governor's administration tied to the federal Rural Health Transformation (RHT) Program. This program, which provided Tennessee with nearly \$207 million for 2026, included policy commitments to pursue "unrestricted scope of practice" for dental hygienists by 2027.

The TDA moved quickly to review the Administration's proposed language

(HB 2556 / SB 2244) and provided formal testimony to the Senate Health and Welfare Committee. The association highlighted critical flaws, including a lack of collaboration with the dental community and the potential risk to patient safety. By deploying legislative contact dentists to voice these concerns, the TDA successfully advocated for the consensus-based model over the Administration's broader proposal. As a result, the Senate version of the Administration's bill was sent to General Subcommittee, effectively ending its progress for the session.

National Reach: Impacting Federal Policy in Washington, D.C.

The momentum from Nashville carried directly into our nation's capital this March. Nearly 500 dentists and dental students from across the country gathered for the 2026 ADA Dentist and Student Lobby Day, and we were proud to have a dedicated delegation of TDA members among them. Our representatives took the Tennessee perspective to Congress, advocating for federal solutions to the systemic challenges facing the profession. Key priorities included:

Insurance Reform: Closing federal dental insurance loopholes through the Improving Dental Administration Act to ensure administrative transparency and fairness.

Student Debt Relief: Championing the REDI Act to help offset the unprecedented educational debt carried by dental and medical residents.

Federal Leadership: Protecting dental leadership and ensuring oral health infrastructure is prioritized across federal agencies.

By participating in ADA Lobby Day, TDA members ensured that Tennessee's voice is heard at every level of government.

Looking Ahead: Preparing for 2027

While we celebrate these successes, the TDA remains future-focused. To that end, we will be convening specialized workgroups over the summer on issues important to the profession including:

- Workforce Development & Scope of Practice
- Fluoridation Policy
- Dental Insurance Reform

These groups will focus on developing refined messaging, gathering additional clinical and technical resources, and identifying key partnerships. By conducting these deep dives now, we will be fully prepared to launch a comprehensive advocacy campaign for our entire legislative agenda when the General Assembly reconvenes next January.

Stay Engaged

Whether it was a workgroup meeting in September, a formal meeting during Day on the Hill, or a quick email sent during a committee vote, every action contributed to a successful session. Our advocacy works because our members participate



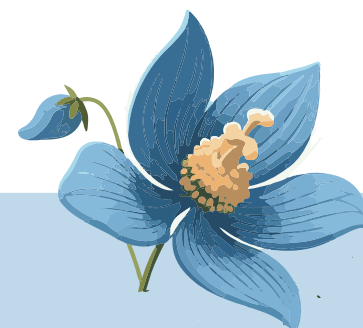

Resources for Job-Seeking Dental Professionals

The TDA Career Center provides great value to job-seeking dental professionals. TDA members can post multiple resumes and cover letters, or choose a career profile that leads employers directly to them. The TDA Career Center provides multiple opportunities to bring jobs directly to job seekers by

uploading public resumes and utilizing Job Alerts. When a resume is set as “public”, employers have the ability to view the candidate’s resume. When they are interested in reaching out to the candidate, the employer completes a contact request form. If the candidate is interested in the company, their contact information is released to the employer. If not, they reject the request which keeps the anonymity of the candidate. Job Alerts also assist in making job searching convenient and accommodating to dental professionals’ busy schedules. When set up, job seekers receive an email every time a job becomes available that matches their desired interests and locations. Job-seeking TDA members are also free to search the jobs database with robust filters to focus on the specific interests. Along with seamless searching for jobs, members also have access to TDA Career Center resources. They can access resume writing tips, interview tips, sample resumes, answers to experts’ frequently asked questions, and more.

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
